Treasurer's Report – Jillian O'Shaughnessy

- Shared budget for all to see how money is being spent
- Massive thank you to previous HSO boards throughout the years for making sure there was a reserve for us to work with this year
- This year's budget is \$30k
- Last year we spent \$24K
- Increase in budget is due to:
 - Adding \$2k for Theme Night Dance
 - \$7,000 for field trips (last year \$6,000 was spent)
 - \$1,500 for Thunderbird Scholarship (last year \$1,000 was spent but \$500 came in this year or it would have been \$1000)
 - Meet the Principal \$600
 - \$500 Grounds Beautification (last year nothing was spent)
 - \$3,000 for Assemblies (last year \$2500 was spent)
 - New Website \$500
- What We have Spent through August: meet the principal, new website and prior year Thunderbird scholarship
- What We are Spending in September: staff appreciation breakfast, getting ready for walkathon: corn maze, cotton candy, hot dog deposit.

- **We had an extremely generous donation for our Walk-A-Thon Petting Zoo which is fully sponsored by Oasis Pool Construction, LOL Yards and Silver Creek Landscaping!**
- Other Fundraisers to help get to \$30K will include: Cookie dough, School Apparel, Artsonia, Minted- all links on our website - you don't have to spend extra money but if you are buying something that these companies sells, use links, & Candy Gram-end of the year with Curbside Confections
- Budget was approved by both presidents in front of all attendees
- Spirit Day Shirts (sponsored by HSO)
 - Described procedure on how the winner was picked including voting process from board members and teachers
 - Shirt will be in the Mahwah Blue color
 - Winner announced- 1st grader Chloe O.
 - Shirts should be available before Spirit Day at the end of the month
- Website- spent summer shopping around different website companies for what would be the best fit
 - Did a demo of the new website, went over every page and explained the menu/toolbar, helpful links, etc.
