If you would like to help but haven't already signed up, please do so via the link below. We need as many families as possible to get involved and ensure there are enough tasters to go around. If all of our students were to attend and bring one family member, we can expect to have in excess of 1000 people in attendance. Whilst most tables are offering a taste of their country, there will also be some larger food items available on the day. These items will operate on a token system, where tokens can be purchased and exchanged for these larger food items.

Displays will be set up in the 'The Street' area, just inside the main entrance of the school. Set up can take place on Friday evening from 6pm - 8pm or on Saturday morning between 9am and 10:30am.
