

PLAYER and PARENT PROTOCOL

Inform Club Covid Officer if you:

TEST POSITIVE. ARE CONTACTED BY TRACK AND TRACE. ARE IN ISOLATION.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME FOR TRAINING

- If you, or anyone in your household, meets one of the following criteria you must not attend training sessions:-
- Has a **high temperature**, a **new persistent cough** and a **loss of smell or taste**.
- No one to attend who is in a school lockdown bubble
- You must have pre-booked to attend the session
- **Make sure you have**
 1. **Kit on ready to play**
 2. **Face mask (if over 11 years old)**
 3. Personal hand sanitiser
 4. Water bottle (Named in full)
 5. Small towel for sweat
 6. Spare T-shirt

ON ARRIVAL

- Arrive promptly but not too early
- No gatherings before and after session anywhere on site
- Parents of over 12s leave players at reception door
- Parents of U12s who wish to watch must have pre-booked, social distance on benches, only return a ball to the group using feet
- Sanitise on entering reception area
- You will be registered in reception and asked to confirm you are fit to train, members of your household don't have symptoms and you are not in an isolation bubble
- There will be a set place for kit spaced at least 2m apart - Coach indicate to players their space
- NO BENCHES to be used for players

DURING THE SESSION

- Follow instructions from Coach and COVID Officer
- EVERYONE is responsible for pointing out anything that they think is not COVID secure
- Avoid using/entering toilets where possible
- ONLY use BOYS changing room toilets
- Do not fill water-bottles from taps in the toilets

Practices

- Try to ensure a 2m distance wherever possible e.g. Hitting drill – queue space 2m apart

Every 30 minutes and at the end of the session all balls to be sanitised as follows:-

- Each player collects a ball.
- Assigned person sanitises hands
- Assigned person sprays each ball and player wipes with blue paper towel
- Paper towels put in Black Bin Liner
- Return ball to basket
- Sanitise hands

- Hand sanitise
- Spray and wipe with blue paper roll
- Paper towel in Black Bin Liner
- Re-hand sanitise
- Leave floor to dry

DEPARTURE

- Sanitise on entering/exiting reception area
- At the end of a session players will be accompanied to car park and checked they are collected safely
- At Crestwood there is a large safe space where parents can wait socially distanced for their child.
- Any hand sanitiser, water bottle, towel, item of kit left at the end of a session will be safely disposed of..

AFTER THE SESSION

Track and Trace explained.

Anyone (or in household) who has symptoms.

- *Immediately contact COVID Officer and Coach.*
- *Isolate and get a test.*
- *COVID Officer and Coach will contact all who attended any session that evening to make everyone aware.*
- *NO ONE WILL BE IDENTIFIED.*
- *COVID Officer will contact your school.*
- *After the test the person concerned will let COVID Officer and Coach know the result.*
- *COVID Officer and Coach will inform the group of the result. Hopefully negative if positive Track and Trace take over.*

OVERALL

STAY SAFE and SENSIBLE by:-

- DON'T attend the session if you feel unwell and/or showing any of the symptoms
- *high temperature*, a *new persistent cough* or a *loss of smell or taste.*
- Washing and sanitising hands regularly
- Wearing a mask everywhere except in the Sports hall
- Keep a 2m distance where possible
- Following the Coaches and Covid Officer's instructions closely
- Look after everyone
