What Our Fight is For:

1. "Democracy in Politics, Democracy at Work!"
2. The complete and total liberation of all the workers within Canada by means of nationalization of all major forms of industry, government and development: to be put to work for all peoples in this land rather than for shareholder profits.
3. The recognition that this land is stolen and to build upon a platform of decolonization, as well as ensuring that the Indigenous Peoples of this land have the right to full autonomy and are directly involved with the decisions made by the Party, especially in how it pertains to their autonomy.
4. Clean running water, habitable housing, and improved food security on reservations now!
5. Expedite the implementation of the 94 Calls to Action of the Truth & Reconciliation Commission
6. The establishment of a government run by and for the workers and not that of the corporate elite, with full representation from all nations and parties/groups (such as workers and farmers, unions, the 2SLGBTQ+ community, the Francophone community, as well as the Islamic community and other minority groups) within Canada
7. The guarantee of housing as a human right, not merely for those who can afford it.
8. Free education for all, education that exposes the hypocrisy of the Canadian Colonial System and the crimes committed against the peoples and workers of this land which focuses on the betterment and reaching of full potential for all citizens.
We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present day society
9. The immediate removal of Canada from foreign conflict and imperialist groups such as the Lima group, NATO, etc and the introduction of Canada as a neutral power with independent foreign policy; as well as the recognition and re-establishment of ties with countries that have been severed or harmed because of the imperialist governments.
10. Support for energy workers (including and especially oil industry workers) as we transition to renewable energy, including the guarantee of new jobs provided (and trained) within a similar field with minimalized wage loss
11. An urgent program and plan of action committed to fighting climate change by transitioning to renewable energy, the end to logging of old growth forests, increased preservation of endangered or threatened eco-systems, tree planting campaigns, etc. As well: the immediate reversal of all privatization of national parks and protected areas across the country, so as to ensure the beauty of this land can be protected for future generations to benefit from and enjoy.
12. Implement an economic recovery plan based on the nationalization of major industries, an immediate freeze on mortgage payments, reversal of and cancellation of eviction notices, hazard pay for all essentials workers as well as potential for backpay,

contain and control the spread of the Covid-19 virus and protect our most vulnerable, as well as provide immediate assistance for all workers, farmers, small business owners, students, etc who have been ignored and left to struggle at the hands of the corporate elite in collusion with the government at both the federal and provincial levels

13. To provide and implement incentives for farmers to transition from mono-culture cropping to bio-diverse and sustainable farming to address issues such as climate change and crop diversity decline.
14. The creation of a centralized “People’s Bank” that will not engage in the exploitation of the people nor in the exploitation of other countries nor their people around the world, based on a policy of mutual cooperation, no interest loans, and secure national investment
15. Create a united front to establish a new socio-political and socio-economic system based on the principles of democratic centralism; to build a society free of class and social divisions, oriented to best suit and support the workers and farmers of all trades and all skills, as well as the peoples of all races and walks of life, from coast to coast. With the main emphasis being on the direct, democratic involvement of the people so as to best address their needs on all levels in all areas.
16. The expansion of the nationalized healthcare system to include and cover all programs such as dental care, mental healthcare, vision care, and pharmaceuticals.
17. We stand and fight for peace, decolonization, workers ownership, land, education, housing, and localized food production. This is our statement, may it serve as our beacon and guide so we may never stray from the principles and aims described here, but that we would adapt and develop our struggle on the basis of historical materialism to forever learn from our past, to propel us evermore to greater heights in our future.
