<p>Write a newspaper article that objectively describes Brian's ordeal and rescue.</p> <p>Write 1+ page</p>	<p>Create a 3X3 comic strip including 3 important events from Hatchet. Make sure to include both dialogue and thoughts of the characters.</p> <p>Idea: StoryboardThat.com</p>	<p>Research plane crash survivors like Brian that were able to survive after the crash. Look for patterns in their survival. Are there other interesting details you want to share?</p> <p>Write 1+ page 2+ sources</p>
<p>Pretend that you are Brian and you are keeping a journal about your thoughts and experiences in the forest. Write a series of at least ten journal entries.</p> <p>Write 2+ pages</p>		<p>Write a ten question test for Hatchet. Include 4 multiple choice, 2 essay, and 4 questions of your choice. You MUST answer each question.</p>
<p>Time to be creative! Write a poem or song written by Brian about his time in the forest! Focus on some of the repeated words from the book for inspiration. Add details about what Brian is going through.</p> <p>Write 1+ page</p>	<p>Author Paulsen uses specific words to convey emotion throughout the book. Choose TEN important phrases, quotes, or passages from the book. For each one write about the author's craft and meaning. How do these words impact the story, what application do the words have for the reader?</p>	<p>Pack a bag for Brian. What are ten things you would pack for Brian? Tell what each item is and tell how he would use it. Everything must fit into a small backpack, so you can't bring too much. Also remember that he is in the wilderness— so a cell phone would be useless. Don't forget to leave room for the Hatchet!</p>
