- must attend a post-secondary institution and must provide letter of acceptance
- must have a minimum of 80% average
- must have a clear Christian testimony and consistent lifestyle and
- must demonstrate leadership qualities
- \$500, a plaque and a letter

☐ Sherwood Park Rotary Club

- must have plans to attend a post-secondary institution in the fall
- must have raised your marks significantly from Grade 11 to Grade 12
- must provide letter of acceptance from your post-secondary institution
- \$1000 and a plaque

☐ Sherwood Park Elks Award

- must have shown commitment to volunteerism and involvement in their school
- must provide letter of acceptance from your post-secondary institution
- \$400

☐ Premier's Citizenship Award

- Plague, letter of commendation and \$200 from SCA Student Council
- is awarded to the student who displays outstanding characteristics in the following areas:
 - a) citizenship in the community
 - b) leadership in school and community activities
 - c) volunteer service in the school or community

☐ Local 28 ATA Scholarship Criteria

demonstrated a high level of achievement. Only a few awarded amongst EIPS students.

Konika Minolta Scholarship

- must be in need of support to pursue their career, education and/or learning goal
- must have demonstrated resilience in achieving their diploma, certificate of achievement, or certificate of completion
- only three students in EIPS are selected for this award
- \$500

☐ Kevin Gaetz Award

- meets the entrance requirements for the program of post-secondary studies to be supported
- has a financial need that would restrict the student's ability to pursue such post-secondary studies:
- demonstrates perseverance and commitment to post-secondary education, which may also be described as desire and determination to pursue further learning in an area of interest.
- \$1000-2000

THE FOLLOWING AWARDS WILL BE DETERMINED BY OUR AWARD'S COMMITTEE

Reverend Harald Throness Ministry Training Scholarship

- \$500 and a plaque
- must be enrolled in a ministry training program (Bible school, missions program other ministry training but not other degrees at a Christian college)
- must be enrolled for the fall term and provide letter of acceptance
- must have a strong Christian testimony and good standing in their Christian Studies course.

The Spiritual Leadership Award

- presented to the student who has demonstrated a passion and commitment to encouraging their peers' spiritual growth
- typically are an active member of the campus life team
- awarded \$100 and letter

The Sherwood Park Alliance Church Missional Engagement Award

- presented to up to three students who are pursuing secular or Biblical based education and can articulate how they believe God is wanting to use them in Kingdom advancement
- applicant needs to be able to demonstrate how they are engaged in missional living and responding to God's call on their life
- \$500 and a plaque

The SCA Service Award***Award may not be presented this year

- presented to a student who has made an outstanding contribution in service at SCA
- plaque and letter and \$500

The Purple Tie Scholarship - The Purple Tie Foundation

- Presented to a student that has demonstrated an interest and participation in social justice issues. This student has volunteered with organizations that have a mandate of ministering to people suffering from injustice.
