Lesson Packages

Payment

Payment is due BEFORE the lesson (or the 1st lesson in the package). Payment can be in the form of cheque, cash, e-transfer to christy@silverfoxequine.com or credit/debit online or at the farm. Please note credit and debit card fees add up. SFE is a small business and those fees add to the cost of the programs. Whenever possible please consider other forms of payment.

Missed lessons

24 hours notice is required to cancel a lesson without charge. Lesson packages must be used within 6 weeks of the first lesson in the package (10 weeks for Green Stirrup packages only). Any expired lessons will not be credited. In the event that a lesson was canceled by Silver Fox Equine, the package expiration date will be pushed forward 1 lesson day. Lessons MUST be canceled by email via info@silverfoxequine.com or texted to Christy 647 203 8348.

Above 30 degrees with a humidex, thunderstorms, or below -20 with a windchill lessons may be partially or fully run as in-barn lessons. In-barn lessons, or horsemanship lessons are a valuable part of learning to ride. In the event a student chooses not to attend a lesson that is fully or partially in-barn, the lesson will be charged and no refund, or make-up will be owed.

Arriving Late

Students that arrive late for their lesson may have their lesson time cut short. If a student arrives more than 15 minutes after their scheduled arrival time, the lesson may be canceled, with no refund or make-up given.

Silver, Rusty & Gold Stirrup

Students must pass or be able to pass the Green Stirrup Test to move into these programs. Students in these programs will **not** have a supervised tack up. If they are under 18, a parent or guardian must be present to supervise them until their mounted lesson starts. In the event that they require continual staff assistance, they will be moved to the Green Stirrup Program.

Silver Fox Equine offers a goal driven program. Goals come in all different types, competitive, non-competitive, testing and horsemanship. Over the past 22 years coaching Christy Chamney, the head coach, has found that practice makes perfect. It is very difficult to make significant and meaningful progress in sport without practise. This is why SFE has decided to move forward with a program of riders that ride a minimum of 2 times per week. This could mean 2 lessons

per week, or moving to a part-boarding program with one lesson and one practice ride per week.

Prices

Green Stirrup (all riders new to riding)

All lessons are private, unless pre-booked as semi-private. Tack up & untack time is built into the lesson.

Semi-Private lessons may be offered for this program at an additional discount of \$15/ lesson

Gold, Silver & Rusty Stirrup

Riders must be able to tack, untack, retrieve and put away their own horses. Riders are expected to arrive 30 min before their lesson & stay 15 min after their lesson.

Lessons booked as privates, will be private only. Private lessons are 45 minutes. Students paying for an “open package” may have a 30 min private, 45 min semi-private or 60 min group (max 4 riders). Open packages are not guaranteed to be private or semi-private.

Part-boarding

SFE is excited to offer a program to those students wishing to show or ride a dedicated horse. Open part-board packages are available for riders still wishing to try different horses.

Lessons booked as private, will be private only. Private lessons are 45 minutes. Students paying for an “open package” may have a 30 min private, 45 min semi-private or 60 min group (max 4 riders). Open packages are not guaranteed to be private or semi-private. Private lessons are up to the discretion of the coach and schedule, if they allow, and may not be available.

SFE offers 2 6 month contract options. April 1st- September 30th & October 1st- March 31st.

Part-boarders MUST have a valid Ontario Equestrian (OE) membership

The Part-board package includes:

- 1 - 3 lessons per week (depending on package)
- Guarantee of your horse or pony for your lesson
- Ability to take your horse or pony off property to shows
- First right to book your horse or pony for at home shows

- No vet or farrier costs
- Ability to use the horses tack, or use your own

Payment

Part-board will be due by the 1st of each month, \$25 late fee for outstanding invoices. Failure to pay by the 5th of the month may result in termination of the contract. Payment can be in the form of cheque, cash, e-transfer to christy@silverfoxequine.com or credit/debit online or at the farm. Please note credit and debit card fees add up. SFE is a small business and those fees add to the cost of the programs. Whenever possible please consider other forms of payment.

Missed lessons

1 make-up lesson will be allowed per month for riders riding 1 or 2 times per week and 2 make-up lessons per month for riders with 3 lessons per week. Make-up lessons must be booked within the month. If no time can be found the lesson will be forfeited.

Lessons must be canceled with 24 hours or more notice to receive a make-up lesson.

Should SFE cancel a lesson, a make-up lesson may be given or a credit towards the following month's bill at the discretion of SFE.

Above 30 degrees with a humidex, thunderstorms, or below -20 with a windchill lessons may be partially or fully run as in-barn lessons. In-barn lessons, or horsemanship lessons are a valuable part of learning to ride. Arriving Late

Students that arrive late for their lesson may have their lesson time cut short. If a student arrives more than 15 minutes after their scheduled arrival time, the lesson may be canceled, with no refund or make-up given.

Refunds

There are no refunds for monthly payments. Should a student wish to end their part-board, they must provide 30 days written notice.

Should SFE choose to end the part-board agreement, they will refund any unused lessons/rides.

Lockers

Should space permit, part-boarders are able to rent a locker. Full sized lockers are \$40/ month, ½ lockers are \$20/ month. Lockers are not guaranteed to be available.

Terms & conditions:

- Contract signed for April 1st- September 30th or October 1st- March 31st.
- No two riders will be able to use the horse for the same height or division
- School horses will have a MAXIMUM of 2 riders part-boarding
- Lessons may be used towards show coaching fee

- Part-boarders will be responsible for all show fees, coaching fees at shows and trailer related fees.
- Part-boarders will have to provide their own show attire for themselves and their horse (other than tack) at off property shows
- Should a horse become ill or unrideable, a suitable replacement will be offered until such time the horse is well again. In the event that a suitable replacement can not be found, the contract can be suspended or terminated without penalty.

Practice Rides

- If the student is under 18, a person over the age of 18 must be present for the duration of their ride
- There is no jumping allowed during practice rides
- The ride must be booked during opening hours (8am-9pm). Students may not arrive before 8am and must be off the property by 9pm
- Rides must be booked on the google calendar and a request sent to Christy by email, text, in-person or phone beforehand
- Every effort will be made to accommodate practice rides, but during peak hours the horse may not be available
- It is recommended to book at least 24 hours in advance
- If you are riding in the evening, every effort will be made for your horse to be inside (or close by) for you. In the event you are canceling a ride, you must inform Christy ASAP, so your horse can put where they are supposed to go.
- Missed practice rides must be made up within the month they are scheduled. Every effort will be made to accommodate missed rides, but during peak hours this may not be possible.
- Rides will be a maximum of 45 minutes in length.
- The part-boarder is responsible for putting their horse where they are supposed to go (stall/ paddock) after the ride.

Build your own package. The minimum requirement is 1 lesson/ week & 1 practice ride/ week.

Leasing

Leasing is a great way to try out horse ownership. Students can lease an SFE horse or split a lease with another rider. Lessors can ride any time during open hours and do not have to book

practice rides. If sharing a lease with another rider they just have to coordinate with the other lesser. The horse will not be used in any lessons other than with the lesser.

Leasing is available on 6-12 month contracts.

Lease fees are \$750/ 6 months +board, vet & farrier costs

Board is \$1300/ month plus \$210-620/ month for lessons, depending on the packages chosen.

Approx vet and farrier costs are \$1000 / year minimum

Blankets & tack are not included. The Lesser is expected to provide all the gear for the horse.
