All people (25 peoples) Help translate 5000 String on MDN.

Goal 2: For the next two month (Mai, June), all people that choose session 1 hold working sessions to develop add-on..

Goal 3: Two month later (July), finalization and submission of the add-on.

Goal 4: In the next six month, all people that choose session 2, hold working sessions for finalization SUMO project Firefox in Nouchi (translation FireFox to Nouchi, Ivorian Jargon).

Question 1: Critical:

- Could you please explain what you mean by "Leadership conflicts"?

Answer:

It there's some conflicts between community members and this is in part due to Bacely Yorobi. When he and Brian Hui came back from Kenya in May 2015, they were made us believe that this community Meetup Representative for Kenya, will be those who will lead Mozilla Africa.

How measure metrics?

- 2) In the next two month, AKA BROU, PHILIPPE KOUADIO, SAINT CYR hold workshop for develop add-on and run Add-on for sumission.

- 3) In the next six month, finilization of SUMO project, Firefox in Nouchi. (ABBACKAR DIOMANDE and Nash CI)
- 4) For next tree month, 500 new FSA, help take back the web.
- 5) The FSA cub Team will face the next challenge:
 - Make A video in which they will present their teams and their schools describe their motivation, their action plan for awareness regarding the protection of data on the web during the three (3) next month.
- 6) Recognition: The best community builder will have Mozilla gadgets, obtain sponsorships, possibility to attend the next Local community Meetup, getting a leadership position in the Mozilla community CI (make from the dream team of Ivory Coast FSA).
