As of 9/9/2024

With pandemic restrictions mostly a thing of the past, the board of the BWC feels we are at a point where singers can self-select their comfort level in terms of singing with a group. We encourage all singers to be attentive to their own health status, stay home when symptomatic/ill, and be considerate of the health of others.

Starting in our fall 2024 semester:

- We encourage those who are eligible to get vaccinated and boosted.
- We welcome singers to wear a mask if they wish, but masks are no longer required at our rehearsals or concerts.
- If you do not feel well or have *any symptoms* of illness, please stay home.
- If you test positive, please email info@brattleborowomenschorus.org and director@brattleborowomenschorus.org.
- Once symptom-free and ready to return to Chorus, please mask *at least* through day 10 of your diagnosis.

Masks

While masks are no longer required, they are optional. **Black masks are preferred for concerts.** Should you choose to wear a mask, we suggest singers to have either a Resonance [Singer's Mask](#) (which can be more pleasant to sing in), or use your own N-95, [KN95](#), or KF94 masks.
