

MAKING A FABRIC COVER FOR AN A6 NOTEBOOK

Materials needed:

A6 notebook – it can be one with a hardcover, a spiral one or a paper one.

A piece of outside fabric the size of the open notebook, plus $\frac{1}{2}$ " so that will give you a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam all around.

A piece of interfacing the size of outside fabric.

Lining fabric – one piece the width of your booklet and 3" shorter than the length.

Two pieces the length of the fabric and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " width of fabric.



METHOD

Decorate the front of your fabric however you want.

Attach the interfacing to this.

You will now have:

A booklet, front fabric that has been decorated on one side, one large lining fabric, two short pieces of lining fabric.

SEWING THE COVER

With the two short pieces of fabric make a hem on one edge of the long sides.

On the larger piece of lining fabric, sew a hem at each end of the width.

Lay outside fabric on the table with right side facing you.

Place the short pieces on top of the main fabric, right sides together.

On top of this place the long piece of lining fabric, wrong side up.

Pin and sew all around.

Turn inside out, press and fit the notebook inside.
