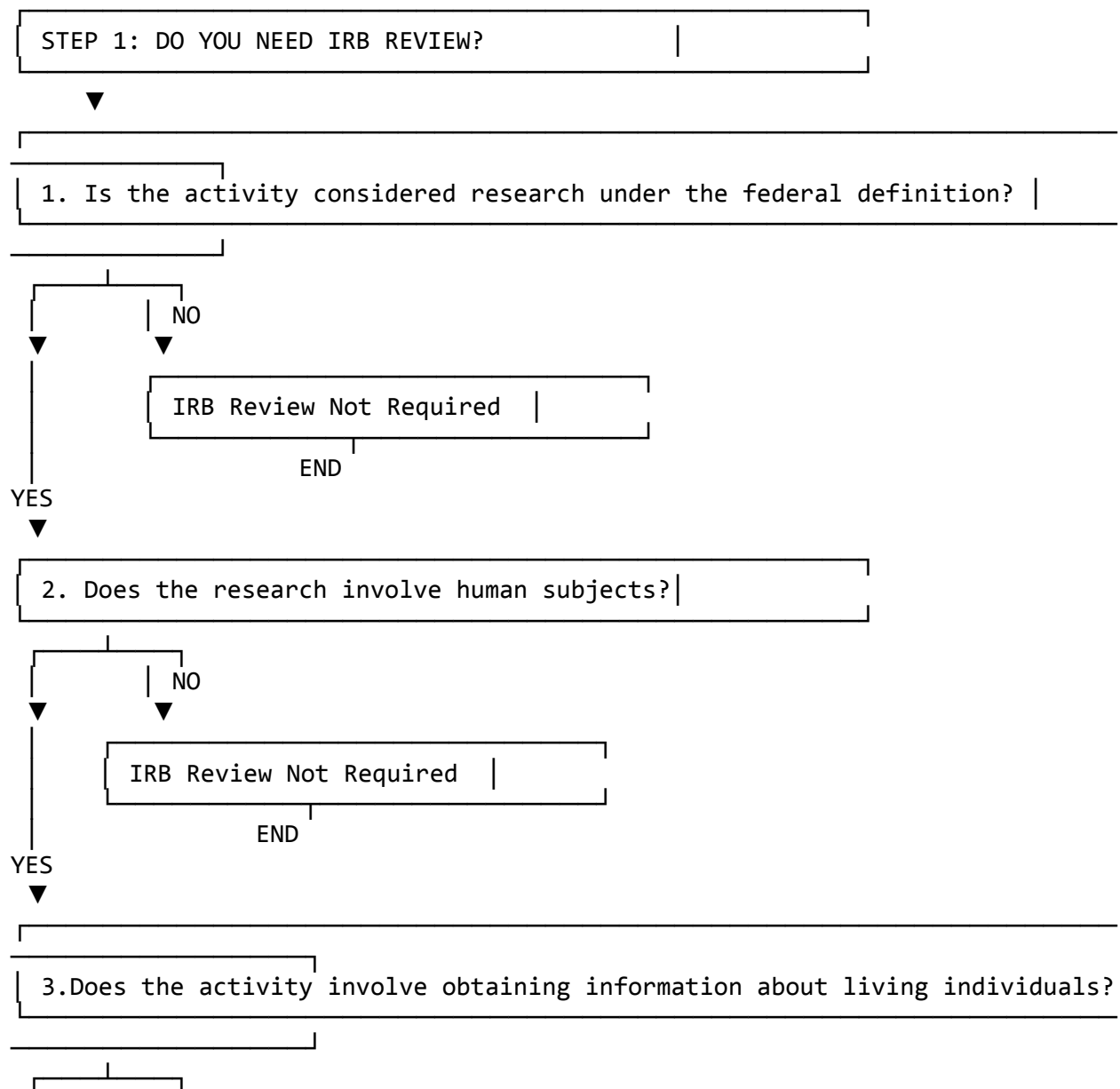
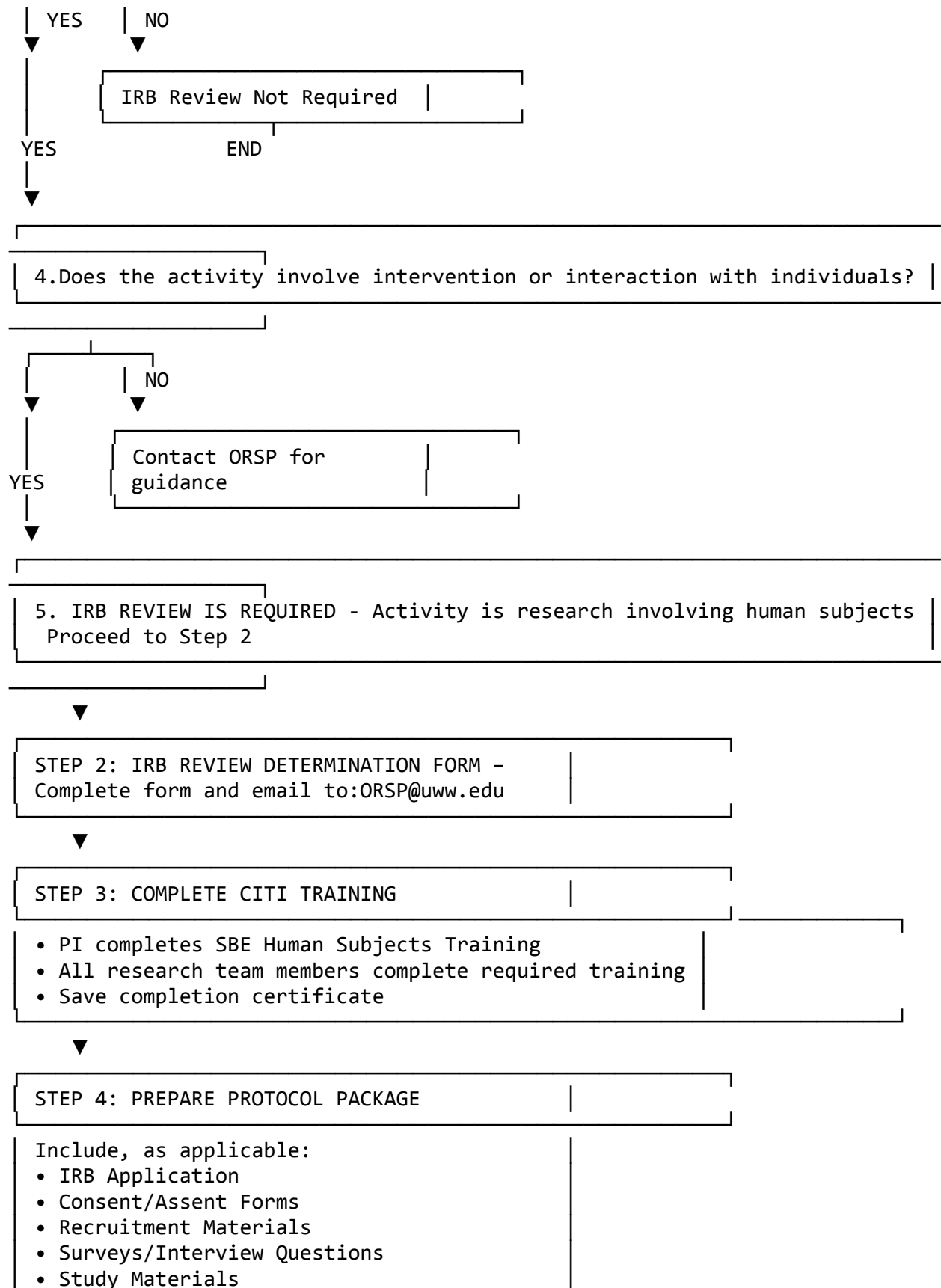


UW–Whitewater IRB Application and Approval Process

Research: A systematic investigation, including research development, testing, and evaluation, designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge. Includes dissemination of research (*active, intentional process of sharing study findings with specific audiences*).

Human Subject: Per regulations 45 CFR §46.102, it is a “a living individual about whom an investigator (whether professional or student) conducting research: (i) Obtains information or biospecimens through intervention or interaction with the individual, and, uses studies, or analyzes the information or biospecimens; or (ii) Obtains, uses, studies, analyzes, or generates identifiable private information or identifiable biospecimens.”

STEP 5: COMPLETE APPLICATION IN CAYUSE

- ORSP creates account
- Log in with UW-Whitewater credentials
- Complete IRB Application



STEP 6: SUBMIT APPLICATION

- Submit protocol package
- Confirm submission
- Certify Investigator Statement
- Notify ORSP Compliance Officer



STEP 8: EXEMPTION DETERMINATION

- IRB/ORSP determines exemption status
- Investigators may NOT self-determine
- If exempt, investigator is notified



STEP 9: IRB Determination

APPROVED	EXEMPTED	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED	DECLINED
Research may begin	Research may proceed	Revise and resubmit	Not approved as submitted



STEP 10: IRB COMMUNICATIONS IRB Decision

Important Reminder

No research involving human subjects may begin until official approval or exemption notification has been received from ORSP/IRB.
