- The JV Tigers got their first win of the season on Saturday at Switzerland County by the score of 49-26. All 9 players scored in the game. Mehyar Safaviyan led the team with 18 points, Andrew Myers 8, Drew Tufts 7, and Jordan Ledesma had 5.
- The varsity boys basketball team opened their season with a 53-47 conference road win at Batesville Friday night. The Tigers played with a lot of intensity and teamwork to finish off the Bulldogs. Jackson Bobo led the Tigers with 14 points and 11 rebounds. Dahya Patel, Reece Denning, and Garrett Yoon each had 10 points. Adam Burd added 5 points and Ashton Craig finished with 4 points.
- The varsity boys basketball team defeated Switzerland County on Saturday 52-37. Jackson Bobo and Dahya Patel led the Tigers with 10 points. Adam Burd added 8 points. Reece Denning added 7 points. Ashton Craig and Logan Rohrer each added 6 points. Garrett Yoon finished out the scoring with 5 points. Andrew Myers chipped in with good defense. The Tigers are 1-0 in the EIAC and 2-0 on the season. Their next game will be Friday at home against Rushville and Monday at home against Taylor.
- The Frosh Tigers were delivered their first loss of the season at Batesville by the score of 35-19. The Tigers were led in scoring by Teagen Bennett with 5 points. Also scoring for the Tigers were Gerrold Taylor with 4 points, and Ben Cornett and Hayden Saylor each with 3 points.
