WE USE WILL: TO MAKE A PREDICTION ABOUT THE UNCERTAIN FUTURE

EXAMPLE: HE WILL BUY THE HOUSE.

TO OFFER OUR HELP TO SOMEBODY OR TO MAKE A PROMISE

EXAMPLE: I'LL HELP YOU

FOR AN EXPONTANEOUS DECISION

EXAMPLE: __ SOMEBODY IS AT THE DOOR

__ I'L ANSWER.

GOING TO

WE USE GOING TO WHEN WE REFER TO FUTURE PLANS OR SOMETHING HAVE DECIDED.

EXAMPLE: WE ARE GOING TO BUY A CAR.

TO MAKE A PREDICTION WHEN THERE IS AN EVIDENCE.

EXAMPLE: LOOK AT THOSE CLOUDS!. IT IS GOING TO RAIN

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

WE USE PRESENT CONTINUOUS WITH A FUTURE MEANING FOR SOMETHING THAT WE

HAVE ALREADY PLANNED.

I'M TRAVELLING TOMORROW.

PRESENT SIMPLE

WE USE PRESENT SIMPLE WITH A FUTURE MEANING

EXAMPLE: TIMETABLES, PROGRAMMES AT THE CINEMA
