- 1. Highlight any classes you have taken in yellow. Include next to the class name how many credits that course is worth. You must have passed the course to count towards a pathway. You may be surprised to find that you completed a pathway without knowing it.
- 2. For an "any" section, make sure to type the class and credits associated below
- 3. Use only the amount of foundational credits needed, if you have extras in the foundations area, they can be used in the supporting section.
- 4. The same class cannot be used in both the foundations AND the supporting section within a single pathway. However, the same class can be used in DIFFERENT pathways.
- 5. Add up credits within a pathway. You must meet the credits of the foundational section and the supporting section. Pathways are 3.5 credits.
- 6. If you are completing a **Warren Tech Program**, you will get a pathway in Human Services or whatever pathway is the closest to your program. For example, if you complete the Video Production Program, you would earn the FVP Pathway and not HUS.
- 7. You will only receive 1 graduation cord regardless of the number of pathways within an Academy (Ex: 1 red cord, even if you have all 3 HHS Pathways). All pathways will be listed on your transcript at graduation
- 8. Each semester is .5 credit. So if it was just a semester class, it is .5. If it is a yearlong class or it appears in 2 different semesters, it is 1.0.
- 9. The pathway exception form is included at the end if you need it.

Other Info

- Each pathway is worth 4.0 credits. Make sure you have the correct number of credits for each section.
- Any Publication class includes: Yearbook, Newspaper, Journalism
- Any Business & Marketing class: Any class listed under the business section in the catalog
- Any Video Production class: Any class listed under the video section in the catalog
- Any STEM elective class: Any class from the Computer Science and/or Engineering & Robotics section of the catalog. This does not include agriculture classes.
- Any Theatre class: Any class from the theatre section in the catalog
