I. Will draw/ Won't draw list

Will draw:

humans/humanoids, female in general, furry, fanart, pin-ups, plump/curvy bodies, mature women.

Won't draw:

loli/shota, babycon, toddlercon, famous/real people, politics, hate art, scat, diaper, eroguro, birth, unbirth, inflation/expansion, necrophilia, hyper.

(if you don't see something enlisted here, you can ask and can be discussed)

II. Creative digital service & Payment Procedure:

1. The payment method it's USD currency.
2. DM me at **Discord: abyssalchimo (Chimo#8972)**
3. When you start ordering a illustration you automatically are taking a **slot service**
4. **BE SPECIFY from the start** what kind of illustration style you want (*sketch, rough cellshade, etc.*)
5. Please provide your character ref and the info that I need for your illustration: concept, situation, expression, etc. Please be clear and simple as possible with your info (A.K.A. no walls of text), any visual ref will help me a lot.

It's also your choice what kind of **pose, view or angle** you want, or you could also let me have artistic freedom if you want.
6. I will inform you of the total price based on the art service sheet prices.
7. Provide your email in your DM to send you an invoice.
8. I will send an invoice to your **EMAIL** that you provided to do the payment that way,
9. I will start work after the payment it's done.
10. **DON'T** take a slot if you're not going to pay when im ready to start with your illustration, leave the slot illustration for someone who is really interested.
11. **if i reach your slot at the queue list and the invoice payment hasn't been made yet, I'll skip you and move on to the next slots after you, leaving you last on the waiting list. But If your turn comes up again and payment hasn't been made, once again I'll skip your turn and move on to the next slots, but this time I'll cancel the invoice to free up your space slot.**

III. General Rules:

1. By hiring my service: **you (the commissioner)** agree with and accept my full terms of service.
2. You must be 18 years old at least to hire my services.
3. You (the commissioner) accept that the drawing will be done in my art style, so reserve requests like "draw in the style of (other artist that it's not me)"
4. **I reserve the right to refuse any commission, edit or alteration.**
5. **absolutely not upfront payments, You (the commissioner) cannot pay before i accept to work with you or get paid before to know what i gonna do without any info for your illustration.**
6. You (the commissioner) understand that I don't give time estimates for your commission and any dates/times are not guaranteed. The commissioner also must understand that they are not paying for a specific day/time and work will be completed in accordance with my schedule.
7. **COPYRIGHT Policy** - You (the commissioner) **DO NOT** have permission to **EDIT** any of my art you have received from me, or hand to third parties to alter any of my work:
 - a. You cannot **CUT off** my **LOGOS/SIGNATURES** from my art under any circumstances.
 - b. You (the commissioner) and **THIRD PARTIES** are **TOTALLY NOT ALLOWED TO USE MY ART AS A BASE** to profit, my art is protected under copyright policy.
 - c. If you pay **third parties** by yourself or **third parties** charge you by altered art of my authorship used as a base, you are by your own.
 - d. **Adopts:** in the case that i sold you an Original character of my own creation (from part of my **CLOSED** species/concept, etc): the only thing that i selling you it's the design from that one only character, not the whole species/concept to use as a **BASE** concept to make your own OC's/RECOLOR to profit.
 - i. With this sold character, you only chose: name, backstory, personality, gender, etc.
 - ii. you can re-sell only on the same price that you get the character (if you add more art to the character, can increase the price with no problem)
 - e. You (the commissioner) may use their own commissioned art pieces for a **limited personal use** only, you cannot profit from commissioned artwork in any way, including:
 - i. for advertising or commercial use (merch, third party merch, third party patreon, nft, etc.) **i can do an exception if I give you prior permission and/or receive monetary compensation**
 - ii. **'personal use'** does not include using paid artwork (or portafolio) to train **artificial intelligence (ai)**, even if said training it's for "personal use".
 - f. Once you get your **FINISHED** illustration, Commissioners have the right to post their commissioned piece on any personal social media giving me always the credits every time (included adopts)
 - g. You (the commissioner) **DO NOT** have permission to take **SCREENSHOT** of my streams while I work on your commission and post it without credit me
 - h. You (the commissioner) **DO NOT** have permission to post any WIP that I sended you before or after completing your commission, at least not with my prior permission. WIP are for private viewing only.

8. I reserve the right to **Use** my own artwork derived from a commission for visual examples in my art-sites / Portfolio (excluding private commissions).
9. **Character design/draw/customization from 0** Will have an extra fee depending on how complex it's the character, in this category enters:
 - a. humanization and anthropomorphization/furryfication
 - b. redraw AND/OR redesign existing one
 - c. make a reference sheets from 0
10. **Extra Fees:**
 - a. Complexity of the character like: armors, spikes, detailed mechanical parts, complex tattoos, a lot of jewelry, extra limbs or wings, etc, will result in an extra fee up to \$15 or more.
 - b. I can take private commissions but I must be given notice prior to payment that the work is not to be shared online. (Rule 1 above still applies to private work) Private commissions that are requested to never be posted may be subject to an additional fee.
 - c. I reserve the right to request any additional charging and monetary compensation if there are too many edits requests and if the customer is improvising with the drawing with no clear idea.
 - d. For split payments, it can be splitted in 2 payments only, each payment has a fee of %20.
 - e. I reserve the right to request any additional charging for fetishes

I retain the right to use the work for any purpose (in any stage), including advertising, sales, promotional material, etc.

V. Refund Procedure:

In the case of a refund request:

- Refunds can only be given in full if illustration has not been sketched (started).
- There's no refund due dissatisfaction on a finished artwork
- If a illustration is partially worked on, I will keep payment equivalent to the amount of work done on the illustration and refund the rest. This is judged based on my set prices in my price sheet.

VI. Work Process:

Sketches:

- No work in progress shots are given for sketches (this because the WIP its very close to the final product)
- Major changes are not allowed to this kind of service, Minor changes are up to my discretion.

Lineart and colorings:

- Sketches will be sent to the commissioner for approval.
- Minor changes are up to my discretion, you can request 1 major change at the sketch stage free of charge
- Additional changes/alteration requests will cost \$15-\$35
- i proceed to finish your illustration
- I won't make any **major** changes once the Lineart and color it's started or done

"major change": different clothes, pose, angle, hairstyle. Reduce or increase something drastically (boob, mass, legs, etc...)

"minor change": adjust color, add minor lines or details i forgot from your ref sheet, reduce or increase something discreet

FAQ

What resolution/size do I work on?

- for sketches, i work on a canvas size of 2250x2250 pixels
- For linearts & cellshades I work on a canvas size of 12.6x18.9" (32x48 cm) in a resolution of 300dpi but other sizes need to be specified by the commissioner if it's necessary.

What is your average turnaround time?

I am open to 10 slot, you can expect to have your illustration completed within 1 or 2 weeks depending on:

- which kind of illustration you paid.
- ...how much free time I have after irl work/weekends
- how complex it is
- your place on the list/slot
- (see general rule #6)
