

Name of branch: Overwatch

Heraldry: Description and image

We will be going with a green shield with white bordering, a left facing bear head on the shield, center placed.



Location of the branch: Puyallup, WA. Historically we will be located in Ireland.

Purpose of the branch: Our first purpose will always be to have fun, but also for fellowship of like minded people that enjoy the re-creation of the medieval times in arts, sciences, crafts and combat.

Branch Customs: Our branch welcomes all arts and customs of the medieval eras within reason. We will have and welcome fighters both steel and rattan, the arts, music, cooking, brewing, weaving, calligraphy, etc.

It is also important to note our branch will be all inclusive on race, sexuality, gender identity, etc. We will not tolerate bigotry, etc. in our branch.

Leadership: The leader will be picked by vote of the populace in a fair manner to all participants. Throughout the year there will be events for all aspects martial and otherwise. There will be an arts and sciences competition, a rapier competition, steel and rattan combat competitions, etc. and from these winners of each will emerge. There will be a vote of whom the populous wants to lead. They will be named the leaders for the next term. Whomever wins leadership may choose their second to co-lead the branch with them.

Leader Title: At this level of branch, we are going with Chieftain/Chieftess

Responsibilities of the leader: To help plan events, coordinate people, keep the law of the

land, hear the desires of the populous, acknowledge the service of members of the branch, grant awards and favors, serve the people, grow the branch by coming up with ways to promote.

Leadership time limit: 1 year unless re-selected by populace

Leadership challenges: A vote will be called to see if the populace feels the need for leadership to change and if so the runners up from the previous vote will take leadership, if the vote calls for no change those that called the vote must appear to the populace meeting and before the branch leaders so that they may be heard, and some resolution reached for the goodwill of all.

Other branch positions:

Branch positions will be subject to change or stay with transition of leadership based on the decisions of the leadership. This will be because these positions will be working hand in hand with the leadership to govern the branch and as such a good working relationship must be present. It is important to note that one person can hold more than one title if the need arises and they are capable of filling that need without detriment to themselves or the populace.

- Comhairleoir (Core-lair)- council to the branch leadership. These are in effect the “elders” or “wise” people that are acknowledged by the leaders and help in decision making for the branch based on the wants and needs of the populace. One of their primary focuses is to help the branch leadership keep up with the service its members have provided so that they may be recognized as such.
- Oiliúnoir (Eh-lee-noir)- these are the individuals selected to train new warriors, be it steel, rattan, rapier, live weapons, archery, etc. the title would reflect the exact position denoted at the beginning “Steel Oiliúnoir, Rattan Oiliúnoir, Live Oiliúnoir, etc.”
- Airgid (Air-eh-gud)- to be appointed by leadership to handle matters of the treasury. This person keeps track of the spending and budget of the branch as well as any donations incoming, etc.
- Múinteoir (moon-chore)- This is the title for teachers of the arts and sciences whom take new people under their wing to learn different crafts, trades and arts it would be denoted after, which of these. “Múinteoir of brewing, Múinteoir of calligraphy, etc”.
- Cainteoir (con-char)- This is the position of the person who relays messages to the populace from the leadership, be it vocal announcements at events, or helping with the web posting to the populace online. This person keeps the communication flowing as well as welcoming new members into the group and acting as a tour guide for them.
- Cneasaí (crass-sea)- This is an appointed medic for the undertaking of first aid at events and/or first responding at events.

- Coimeádaí- (com-mah-dea)- This is the keeper of minutes and records for events. They will record minutes of meetings as well as the results of tourneys and who has served in any capacity, the branch.

Yearly Event: Our yearly event will be “Korangar” and will be held here on the West Coast. It will include as many aspects of the medieval times as we can muster. We would like to hold this event in August every year.
