Overview:

2. Choose ONE quote from the beginning, ONE from the middle, and TWO near the end of your book that addresses or comments on the essential question. (That's 4 quotes from your book)
3. Craft 3-4 sentences analyzing each quote. Prompts to help with your analysis: What interested you about this moment in the text? Why did you choose this quote? How did this piece of evidence impact your understanding of the reading?
