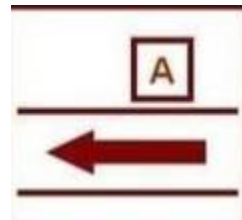
computer lab. The library can be found the gym, while the science labs are located at The west wing.

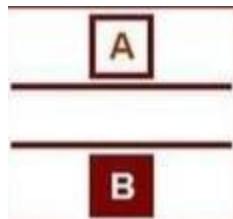

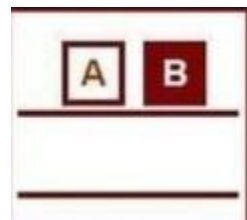




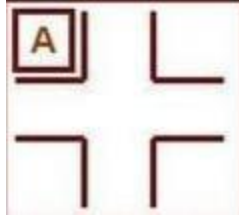
