Young Dancers

- Hair for all classes: secured away from face
- · Jewelry should be limited and not distracting
 - No dangling necklaces, earrings, or bracelets

Creative Movement, PreBallet & Tap, Beginning Ballet

- o Option 1
 - Blue dance dress or leotard and skirt
 - pink or flesh-tone tights or thin white socks
 - pink or flesh-tone ballet shoes
- o Option 2
 - Black above-knee shorts and fitted white t-shirt
 - black socks
 - black ballet shoes
- Ballet 1
 - Option 1
 - Black leotard
 - pink or flesh-tone tights
 - pink or flesh-tone ballet shoes
 - Option 2
 - Black above-knee shorts and fitted white t-shirt
 - black socks
 - black ballet shoes

Beginning Tap & Jazz and Beginning Contemporary Modern

- Solid color leotard or fitted athletic top
 - No crop tops
- Black fitted shorts or pants; leggings; or tights (if leotard is worn).
- Solid color socks (optional)
- Shoes
 - Tap: black tap shoes
 - Jazz: black jazz shoes
 - Contemporary Modern: bare feet

Upper Level Classes:

For all classes:

- Hair for all classes: secured away from face
 - teachers will give more details if a class has specific hair needs
- Jewelry should be limited and not distracting
 - No necklaces, bracelets, or dangling earrings
- No crop tops

Classical Ballet

- Ballet 2 and up
 - o Option 1
 - Black leotard
 - pink or flesh-tone seamed tights
 - pink or flesh-tone ballet shoes
 - Optional: flesh-tone camisole leotard worn under the black leotard
 - o Option 2
 - Opaque black ballet tights (footed or footless with black socks)
 - white fitted shirt
 - black ballet shoes

Jazz, Tap, Contemporary Modern

- Jazz and Contemporary Modern
 - Any style solid color leotard or fitted athletic top (must cover midriff)
 - Black tights, leggings, jazz pants, or above-knee shorts
 - Shoes
 - Jazz: black jazz shoes
 - Contemporary Modern: bare feet
- Tap
 - Any clothes students can easily move in
 - Shoes
 - Tap: Black lace up tap shoes
