- 1. **flukes:** the flat horizontal lobes that form the tail of the whale.
- 2. **krill:** tiny, shrimp-like crustaceans that are food for whales.

- 4. drift: carried along by wind or water.
- 5. calm: very still.
- 6. thrust: to push outward with force.
- 7. **echo:** repeating sound; when sound bounces off a surface
- 8. flails: to move wildly.
- 9. **nudging:** to gently push with an arm or elbow.
- 10.immense: very large; huge.
- 11. **heave:** to push or toss with great force.
