WHAT IS THE STATE THESPIAN FESTIVAL? Each year, Texas Thespians host two state-wide festivals with over 10,000 delegates in attendance. As one of the largest annual Thespian events in the nation, the festival offers students and troupe directors an entire weekend immersed in theatre—competitions, workshops, performances, and celebrations of the art form.

WHO CAN ATTEND? Attendance is open to current Thespians as well as select non-Thespian students who are in good standing with Ms. Phillips.

What does "good standing" mean? We seek student leaders who demonstrate:

- A genuine passion for theatre and a desire to grow their skills.
- Commitment to competing or participating at a **high level**, as all delegates will be involved in a competition or event.
- Academic responsibility, with all assignments up to date. (We strongly prefer students with A's and B's, since the festival requires missing two days of school before Thanksgiving break.)
- Respectful behavior, the ability to follow directions, and a focused attitude.

Because this is a serious commitment, and this event is so large, students who are primarily interested in socializing or "goofing off" will not be considered. Delegates must show they are self-motivated, dependable, and serious about representing Decatur High Theatre.

How are students selected? Non-Thespian students may be invited by Ms. Phillips, with input from current Thespians, based on the above criteria. Space is limited, so students who exemplify dedication, responsibility, and enthusiasm for theatre will be given priority.

<u>Transportation</u>: Via van or mini bus to our hotel which is near where ThesFest will take place. We will be shuttling back and forth between our hotel and the event across the street.

What to Pack:

- Posted on Instagram what to pack and the theme of each day. We usually wear our Decatur theatre shirt the day we travel to the Festival (Wednesday). Last year's BLACK shirt
- CHECK the weather and bring layers. When waiting for the shuttle, if we stay at Great Wolf, we will have to stand outside a bit.
- Students are competing on Thursday and/or Friday and must wear Audition
 Dress Blacks/Darks. Please make sure they are ironed and try not to get them
 too wrinkled in packing.
- Bring layers to adjust to the weather and temperature in the rooms. A lightweight hoodie/jacket will work.
- Bring a lightweight backpack to store items purchased or picked up from colleges.
- YOUR CHARGER! An extra charger! and find out who has the same phone as you so you can borrow each other's charger. (Chargers are over \$40 at the hotel)
- Your meds and necessities.
- Shower items.
- Hair/Makeup items.
- Each room should get together and talk about what snacks they are bringing. Waters, crackers, sweets, breakfast, etc. If you have medications, please talk to me. Who is bringing an emergency sewing kit, Band-Aids, etc?
- Travel sized items. The more you pack, the more you will be responsible for
- Please only bring what you can manage to carry. Does anyone have a compact or folding wagon

Spending Money: UPDATE: The Gaylord is a cashless venue. If your child does not have a debit/credit card, there is a terminal in which you can insert cash for a card that is loadable. The Thespian Store does take cash. Parents, talk with kiddos about how much to spend each day.

<u>Music</u>: We will bring the theatre's speaker, but please feel free to bring your own Bluetooth speaker if you don't want to carry ours, as it is heavy and bulky. If you are competing in a solo musical, you are responsible for the speaker.

GRADES/ASSIGNMENTS: Students need to be passing all classes and have the Permission slips signed. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL MISSING ASSIGNMENTS. PLEASE COLLECT YOUR HOMEWORK PRIOR TO MISSING

CLASSES. After Thanksgiving break, it is YOUR responsibility to AGAIN see if you are missing work and to turn in assignments missed while we were out.

You have already paid for two meal vouchers. (to be used for lunches on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday). I suggest packing breakfast snacks and ramen. Bring breakfast snacks or \$ for Thursday-Saturday. Our hotel has breakfast options for \$15, or bring a protein bar/cereal bar. Roommates are encouraged to speak with each other regarding snacks to help keep the cost down at ThesFest.

Souvenirs : There is lots of fun-stuff at ThesFest, ranging from theatre T-shirts, shorts
buttons, bracelets, hats, hoodies, backpacks, makeup, etc. You are not obligated to
purchase anything. If your budget allows, know that shirts range from \$15-\$25,
bracelets are usually \$1.00. An ITS backpack is \$65.

WHY WE ARE GOING?: To learn and to compete, to better our skills, and hone our craft. We will get a chance to visit college representatives. Hopefully, we will also ignite a greater passion for theatre. There are some professionals who teach the workshops, but mostly from other teachers. Take Improv classes, lighting workshops, audition workshops- anything that will help you become a more knowledgeable artist. We will represent Decatur, Decatur High School, and the DHS Theatre Department. This is not a social event or a vacation. In fact, if we do this right, you will be exhausted from preparing and learning. We will behave with the utmost decorum.

THESPIAN FESTIVAL SCHEDULE (2024– FOR REFERENCE ONLY)

National Qualifier: Receiving a Superior rating from each of the three judges. Students, please refer to your handout. Three superiors may qualify you to be considered for the Main Stage. These are the top performers from the entire festival. Musical events Superiors: 21-24 per judge (3;) and Acting event Superiors: 18-20 per judge (3).

What if I become a National Qualifier: You have earned the right to go to Bloomington, Indiana (Indiana University) to compete at the National level, against students from all over the US, and other countries!! Nationals: Take place June 21-26, 2026 in Bloomington Indiana at Indiana University. It is costly but so worth it! This festival is almost a full week & all meals are included and

a t-shirt. NOTES:

- We will check luggage before we load the bus. You will not pack illegal items. No alcohol, drugs, vapes, etc. Please pack discrete items separately. We do not intentionally want to cause embarrassment. The safety of our kiddos is most important.
- No family members can attend this festival.
- There is **ICE** this year, but we may not get tickets when we register. We will have to register for the event there, if we want to go. IF WE DO GO- Then pack gloves and a hat! The cost is \$19.99 with coupon code: Thespians
- We will have a curfew each night. No one leaves his/her room after 10:00 PM
- We must attend a certain amount of workshops. If I am not in a workshop or show with you, you must take a picture of where you are and send it to the Remind group.
- We will not travel anywhere alone. You will have a ThesFest Buddy.
- You cannot go back to your hotel room whenever you want. I will keep your hotel keys with me. IF there is an emergency, obviously I will let you go back to your room. UPDATE: We are staying at the
