
Kearoa is the name of our marae. Kearoa arrived to Aotearoa on the Te Arawa waka. Her partner is Ngātoroirangi.


Ko ēnei ngā whānau, ngā tāngata o tō mātau marae

These are the families and people of our marae

Whakapapa iho mātau i a Kearoa, i a Tuarā. Rāua tahi i tae mai i runga i te waka o Te Arawa. Ka hono a Kearoa rāua ko Tuarā i a Rangiwāhitū rāua ko Te Uira. Ko Ngāti Kearoa (Kea) Ngāti Tuarā te ingoa o tō mātau hapū.

We descend from Kearoa and Tuarā. They both arrived on the Te Arawa waka. These two lines join with Rangiwāhitū and Te Uira. Our hapū is Ngāti Kearoa (Kea) Ngāti Tuarā.

Ko ēnei ngā kōrero mō tō mātau hapū me tō mātau marae

This is our hapū and marae story

Kearoa Whare Tupuna

I nohoia te whenua nei e Haukapuanui. He uri nā Kearoa rāua ko Ngātoroirangi. Nā wai rā ka whānau mai a Rangiwāhitū. Ka moe i a Te Uira. He uri nā Tuarā. Ko ngā whānau o Kearoa Marae he uri nā Rangiwāhitū, nā Te Uira, otirā nā Kearoa, nā Ngatoroirangi, nā Tuarā.

I hangaia a Kearoa i te tau 1888 i te pūtake tonu o te maunga o Horohoro. I te tau 1920 i hunuku te nuinga o Ngāti Kearoa Ngāti Tuarā ki Tārewa Pounamu, he whenua anō nō rātau, kimi mahi ai, noho ai hoki. I haria te whare ki Tārewa Pounamu ka whakatūria ki te taha o te whare tupuna Taharangi. He whare anō nō te hapū nei.

Nā wai rā ka whakahokia te whare tupuna ki Horohoro ki te wāhi e tū nei ia i tēnei wā tonu. Kai reira kai te taha o tō mātau awa ko Pōkaitū, kai te marumaru o tō mātau maunga ko Horohoro.

Hakapuanui was believed to be the first of Ngāti Kearoa to live at Horohoro. A descendent of Kearoa and Ngātoroirangi. In time came Rangiwāhitū. He married Te Uira. A descendent of Tuarā. The families of Kearoa Marae are descendants of Rangiwāhitū, of Te Uira, of Kearoa and Ngātororirangi, of Tuarā.

Kearoa was built in 1888 at the base of Horohoro mountain. In 1920 the majority of Ngāti Kearoa Ngāti Tuarā moved to Tārewa Pounamu, also their tribal lands, to find work and establish homes. The house was also taken to Tārewa Pounamu and erected next to the ancestral house Taharangi. Also, an ancestral house of this sub-tribe.

In time the ancestral house was returned to Horohoro to its current location. To be with the river Pōkaitū in the shadows of our mountain Horohoro.

He aha ō mātau hiahia mō tō mātau marae?

What do we want for our marae?

'He Kaitiaki mātau te hapū o nāianei mō ngā uri hapū o āpōpō - We are the Guardians of our hapū today for our tribes descendants tomorrow'

Our wawata or hiahia are based on our Ngāti Kearoa Ngāti Tuarā tikanga and kawa. Therefore as guardians all that we want for our marae are future focussed to ensure we leave a robust and active marae for generations to come

We have listed our wawata, our hiahia below in a table. These are our current (April, 2022) wawata for our marae. They will constantly be reviewed and may change based on the hapū and marae committee needs are re-prioritised.

Ko te ao o-nehe hai tūāpapa mō te ao o-āpōpō?

How will we take our past to the future?

All that we have now as Kaitiaki has been left to us by the Kaitiaki o muri. Our hapū knows our whakapapa, our kōrero, our whenua, our tangata. Through previous projects and the kaha of our koeke and kaumātua we have been able to retain our Ngāti Kearoa Ngāti Tuarātanga to pass on to future generations. We use all of this as a building block for our uri whakaheke. This will be passed on through actively taking part in hui, wānanga, tangi, huritau, kōrero by individuals, whānau and the hapū as a whole.

Kia hoki mai te tangata ki tōna marae

How will we draw dispersed whānau and hapū members back to the marae?


