The Maryland Port Administration's (MPA) mission is "to stimulate the flow of waterborne commerce through the ports in the State of Maryland in a manner that provides economic benefit to the citizens of the State." In support of this mission, the MPA's Dredged Material Management Program continues to pursue Innovative Reuse (IR) and Beneficial Use (BU) as a sustainable material management solution for the 5 million cubic yards of sediment dredged from the Chesapeake Bay and Harbor shipping channels that service the Port of Baltimore each year.
