Student Expectations for Remote Learning

1. Students are required to turn on cameras for remote class sessions and show their faces on the screen. Student video must be on at the beginning of the period for attendance purposes and all other lesson activities required by the teacher. These expectations must be met in order to earn attendance credit.
2. Students should be in an area that minimizes background noise and distractions. You are also encouraged to apply an appropriate virtual background and use headphones. Please review the [Virtual Backgrounds Tutorial](#); this short video explains how to create, manage, and troubleshoot virtual backgrounds in Zoom and Meet.
3. Class participation is limited only to those students enrolled in the class. No other people can watch and/or listen to the lesson.
4. Never enter a Google Meet or Zoom session for a class in which you are not enrolled. Do not share meeting IDs or links with students outside of class.
5. Students are expected to act in a school appropriate manner during all remote classes just as expected in the traditional classroom setting. Students are prohibited from taking screenshots or screen recordings of remote classes. This includes photos and/or videos of other students and faculty members.
