



Carousel

The Carousel strategy promotes collaborative learning as students exchange ideas. This occurs in a rational sequence with all groups in the class.

Procedure

1. Have students work in small groups
2. Each member of the group shares their ideas about a project, article, or research report.
3. One student is chosen to be a designated speaker who will share this information with others
4. On a signal by the teacher, the remaining members of the group move to another group and listen to that group's speaker.
5. Activity continues until all groups have visited all groups.
