#### **OPTIONS AFTER HIGH SCHOOL**

#### 4-Year College or University, Community College or Trade School

- → If you are planning to apply straight to a **4-year college**, applications are primarily due in the fall and there will be various other deadlines throughout the year.
  - UCs and Common App Schools require personal statements. Check out the prompts here: <u>UC Personal Insight Questions/Common App Prompts</u>
- → Community College there are so many different avenues to pursue in our Community Colleges. See our College of the Month below for more information.
- → **Trade Schools** deadlines vary throughout the year and many are built into Community Colleges like Sierra College and American River College.



#### Here are some important admission/application dates and deadlines for you to keep in mind this year:

- ★ It's OPEN: <u>UC Application</u> and <u>Common App</u> for Fall of 2025 are now open
- ★ October 1st: CSU Application Opens & Submission Open for UC App
- ★ October 1st: FAFSA/CADA Expected to Open (*Tentative*)
- ★ December 1st: UC Application Final Deadline Dec.1st
- ★ December 2nd: CSU Application—some CSU's have additional extensions
- ★ March 2nd: FAFSA/CADA Priority Deadline
- ★ May 15th: Final Date to Commit to a UC College, Out-of-State, Private, and Trade Schools have varying deadlines!

## **TOPIC OF THE MONTH:** Preparing for Scholarships & Letters of Recommendation

Now is an excellent time to begin preparing for your scholarship and college applications. Two great ways to get ahead is to start working on your scholarship applications and your letter of recommendation requests. Getting them done will help make your scholarship and scholarship applications a breeze. <u>Placer High School's Senior Scholarship Application</u> is an application template that many of our scholarship opportunities use as their application and includes the following items.

- Checklist for each application packet
- Template for help you build your resume
- Student writing responses you will use in your scholarship applications

<u>Placer High School Letter of Recommendation Request Instructions</u> will be needed if you are requesting a letter of recommendation from any Placer High School staff and includes instructions for your request. It can also be used when requesting letters of recommendations from outside sources. Keep in mind that you need to **allow at least two weeks** for your request to be completed.
