Math

A palindrome is a word or number that is the same backwards as it is forward such as, racecar or 1221. $12+21=33$. The sum is a palindrome. Think about the numbers 0-99. Try adding a number with its reverse such as $46 + 64$ or $95 + 59$. Do this five times. What do you notice about the answers? Will this always happen for numbers between 0-99. What about numbers larger than 99?
