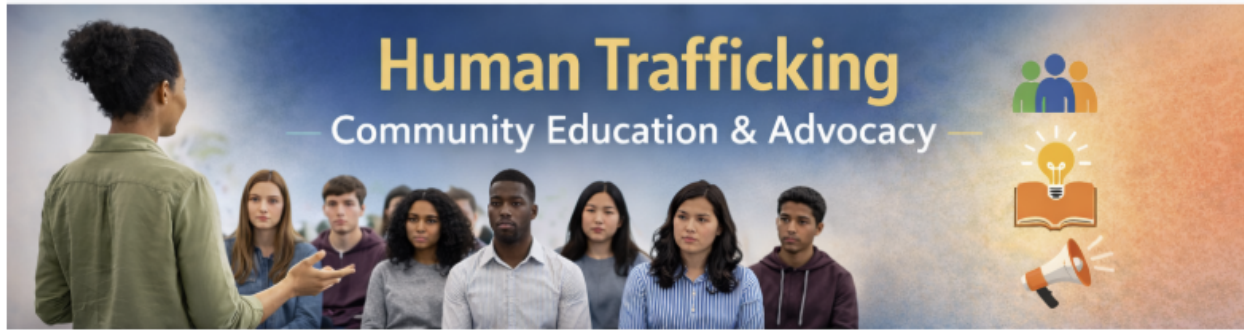




Human Trafficking 101 - Survivor Panel Interview

Who are we and Why are we doing this work?: We are community members that live, work, or attend school along 82nd Ave. We care deeply about centering the voices of those with lived experience to enhance public understanding of this growing issue. Providing a platform to address the reality of commercial sexual exploitation in our neighborhood, **especially as it directly impacts youth along the 82nd Avenue corridor.** By centering the voices of those with lived experience, community members gain clear insight into how traffickers exploit systemic vulnerabilities and target minors—who legally cannot consent to commercial sex.

Why we are fundraising: When people share their personal stories of trauma it takes an emotional toll and valuable time. We are fundraising to pay them because:

- **It values their effort:** Sharing lived experience is work and expertise, not just a casual story, so they deserve fair payment for their time.
- **It makes participation fair:** Offering payment ensures that anyone can afford to participate, not just people who have spare time or extra money.
