



## Marshall County School System has introduced a new school lunch payment system, LINQ Connect 2024.

**LINQ Connect is a secure, online payment system that allows parents to:**

- Make an online payment to their children’s cafeteria accounts.
- Remotely monitor their children’s accounts.
- Set up automatic recurring payments.
- Set up low-balance email message alerts.

### **Fees:**

There is a \$2.85 convenience fee per transaction charged by LINQ Connect for prepayment to cafeteria accounts.

**NOTE:** Funds can be deposited to your child’s account via check or cash and there is no transaction fee.

**Register:** Create an account at <https://linqconnect.com> and select register.

**Verify Account:** Click the email verification link sent to the provided email address to verify your account.

**Sign In:** Sign in at <https://linqconnect.com> using your email and password. Please note: You will need to add your student(s) to your LINQ Connect account.

Click on +, then type, Marshall County School District in the “District\*” field and complete the information to link your student; First Name, Last Name, Birthdate, and School

*You will need to complete this process for each student you wish to add.*
