§4 All selves are universal consciousness. We will call it One. One is an unbounded field of subjectivity and the fundamental level of reality. You are One, and One is you. One can never be found as an object in your awareness. One *is* awareness itself. You've forgotten this due to dissociation and amnesia. §7 The result of materialism is unprecedented suffering on all levels of our natural world: The climate crisis, the environmental crisis, the biodiversity crisis, the health crisis, the mental health crisis, the spiritual crisis, and the societal crisis. We will call this The Sevenfold Crisis. Only through the illusion that we are separate entities in a meaningless universe, can we continue to hurt nature and our next of kin by promoting division, inequality and fear, rather than oneness, equality and love. And yet, materialism can never sustainably satisfy the void we feel inside, as it is the very cause of it.

§8 The void of meaning comes from not understanding and living according to our true nature. Only when we become aligned with the nature of universal consciousness, will we find inner peace and outward purpose. Thankfully, there's a movement coming from all corners of the world to lead us out of the materialist depression and usher in a new consciousness-centric worldview for humanity. It's called metaphysical idealism and it's the understanding that the essential nature of reality is mental, not physical. Consciousness is the fundamental level of reality, not matter. Home of One is here to help make this fundamental truth widespread and much more than an intellectual exercise.
