Attentions Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors:

Pine Island High School will be offering the ASVAB Career Exploration Program on Wednesday, March 6. This test is open to sophomores, juniors, and seniors and will be administered free of charge. The ASVAB can provide students with the opportunity to learn more about their strengths in relation to future academic success and career interest areas in both college and the military.

<u>What is the ASVAB?</u> The ASVAB is a test that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military. For more information about this exam, please visit https://www.asvabprogram.com/parents-test. We will be offering the computerized version of the test.

<u>Who should take the ASVAB?</u> Students may choose to take the ASVAB if they are contemplating a career in the military, would like to further explore how their interests translate to career opportunities, or would like additional practice testing in a standardized environment.

Students interested in taking the ASVAB can sign up by emailing Mrs. Hoeppner by Friday.

March 1. The test will be free of charge and students will be excused from classes the morning of the test. Students taking the ASVAB should report to the Forum Room by 8:15 a.m. on March 6 with your computer. Testing will take up to 3 hours and will be followed by an informational session about scoring and career exploration resources available through ASVAB.




