

Congressman Cold_Brew_Coffee is launching his campaign to become Senator of Dixie today. He has high hopes for this election as he is trying to defeat an incumbent Republican, he is an upstart politician, winning DX-3 by a large margin than founding the Socialist Party with Atlantic's Governor. "I am honored to be here today in this historic venue announcing the launch for a historic election campaign. When I am elected, I will be Dixie's first socialist senator, and I will be unseating an incumbent Republican. Now, many folks have asked why am I choosing to run for Senate instead of sticking in the House, everyone tells me, "Cold, stay in the House, you would win in a landslide!" However, I don't want to take the easy road, I want to turn this country around and make it a better place where all people regardless of wealth, status, or race can live in equality and peace."
