



ChatterPix

(create a talking image)



iMovie

(remove credits, stitch movies)



Aurasma

(bring an image to life)

Use RAFT to create a short script

e.g.

Role	Mint	Role	Heart
Audience	Visitors to a garden store	Audience	Grade 2
Format	Description	Format	Explanation
Topic	What Mint can be used for	Topic	What the Heart does

Find a suitable picture (face, body part, fruit, Herb) of the Role

Use Chatterpix to create a talking picture (use the script)

(The free version of Chatterpix only lets you record for 30 seconds)

If your script is longer than 30 seconds, record multiple chatterpix videos and save them to the Camera Roll

Use iMovie to remove any credits or to join them, save your new movie to the Camera roll

Use Aurasma to bring your image to life

The image is the trigger

Upload your movie as the aura





Stop Motion

(create a stop motion movie)



iMovie

(add a voice over)



Google Photos

(share your video)

Create a stop motion video explaining how to solve one of the problems

Export the movie to the Camera roll,

use iMovie to add a voice over,

export and add the movie to a Google Photos album





Explain Everything

(create a how to video)



Tellagami

(Add some cool animation)



Green Screen

(smash the apps together)

Use explain everything to explain a maths concept (problems available) or features of a volcano or parts of a narrative.

Create a video with tellagami (using a green background)

Use iMovie to remove the audio (detach audio)

Use Green Screen app to combine the tellagami and the explain everything

Add the finished product to the Google photos album

Extension - use Aurasma to show how to solve a problem





Typo Pic

(create a spinning title)



Quicktime

(record your iPad Screen)

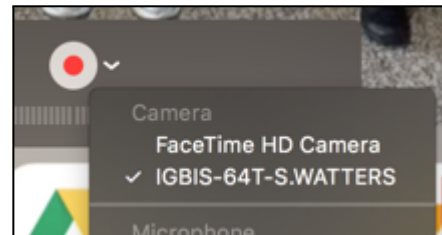
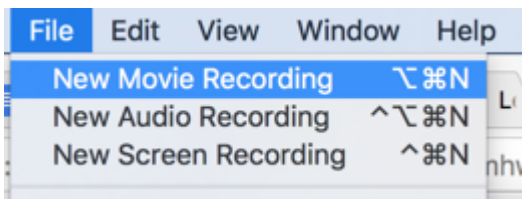


iMovie

Use a cable plugged into a mac and quicktime to capture the ipad screen.

Speed the Movie up, add music trim and crop to create your cool title

Puppet pals

(add a video)

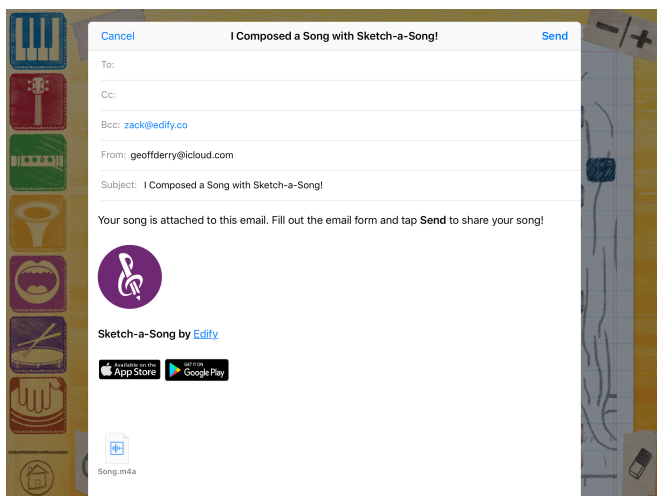
Use the SketchPad App to create some cool music

and email the track to anyone or even a fake email address

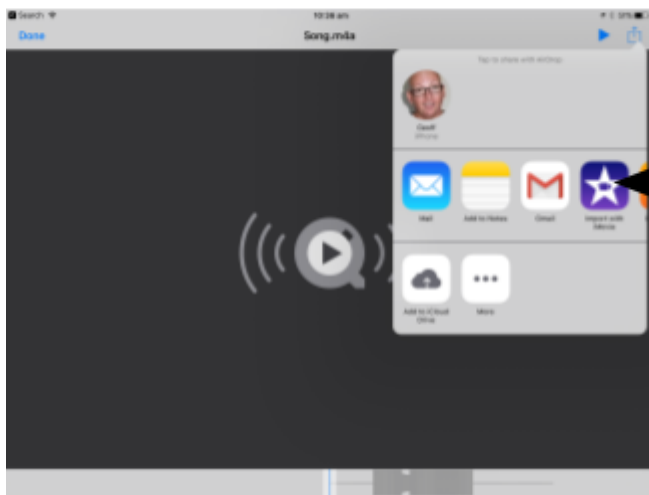


Go to the mail app,

(create a special effect)

(use green screen to add context)

Create a story prompt using Action movie fx and an iMovie trailer, you can also use the green screen app to make it look like there is a reporter on the scene.

Students can then write a report, description or anything at all using the video writing prompt.
