Video Apps

Tool	What It Does
<u>Imovie</u>	Apple's video production tool. Great for editing and has easy to use trailers
<u>Adobe Express</u>	A simple video editor built on a presentation type structure where you build one clip and then the next with the appo putting them all together
<u>Do Ink Green Screen</u>	A Simple Green Screen App that lets students build videos that put them anywhere
<u>Clips</u>	An app that makes it easy to

	create short videos with effects from Apple
<u>Stop Motion Studio</u>	Allows you to easily take pictures and combine them together into a stop motion video

Audio Production Apps

Tool	What It Does
<u>Garageband</u>	Apple's audio production tool. Great for editing
<u>Music Maker Jam</u>	An app built on music creation but lets you build your own audio
<u>Voice Recorder and Audio Recorder</u>	Gives you an app that looks like an old cassette recorder to record audio clips
<u>Music Memos</u>	App meant for songwriters to capture music but can be used in the classroom

Presentation Tools

Tool	What It Does
<u>Keynote</u>	Apple's version of PowerPoint. Works great on Ipad.
<u>PowerPoint</u>	Yep, it's Power Point. Just on your IOS device
<u>Google Slides</u>	It's Google Slides, from your Ipad

<u>Haiku Deck</u>	A presentation maker with great templates and built in images
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Whiteboard Tools

Tool	What It Does
<u>Seesaw</u>	A learning journal app that contains a simple narrated whiteboard feature
<u>Explain Everything</u>	A classic narrated whiteboard tool that has a good pricing structure and works with any device
<u>EduCreations</u>	An app that lets the user create 1 narrated Whiteboard Video at a Time
<u>Show ME</u>	Another narrated Whiteboard App that allows you to draw and record audio

Animation

Tool	What It Does
<u>Tynker</u>	Code Animations
<u>ChatterPix</u>	Animation app that lets you turn inanimate objects into animated ones

Websites

Tool	What It Does
<u>Google Sites</u>	Can be done from Safari. Easiest avenue since most students already have it
<u>Fan School</u>	A Moderated Blogging Platform. Formally, Kid Blog

Social Media

Tool	What It Does
<u>Padlet</u>	An online corkboard that works great to fake Social Media accounts
<u>Class Tools</u>	Has both a fake Facebook generator called Fakebook and a fake Twitter generator called Twister
<u>Nearpod</u>	Nearpod has an activity in it called Collaborate which makes faking Social Media accounts easy

Writing

Tool	What It Does
<u>Word</u>	Yep, its that Word, but it makes a great writing platform on Ipad
<u>Pages</u>	Apple's version of Word. Great for writing projects
<u>Google Docs</u>	Google's version of Word. Has

	great templates and share features
<u>Book Creator</u>	Lets you create a digital book and publish it to the Itunes bookstore

Others

Tool	What It Does
<u>Google My Maps</u>	You will need to set it up on a computer but allows the user to create an interactive map on IPad
<u>Delightex</u>	Have students create their own virtual reality environment
<u>Shapr3D</u>	IOS app that lets you do 3D design and send the design to a 3D printer
<u>Pic Collage</u>	Build collages with images you take on your IPad
