CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION

Our professional learning teams have begun their work together in vertical grade bands: our K-2 teachers and assistants form one team and our 3-5 teachers and assistants form a second team. We have started

- Digging into student data for determining skill gaps and areas where students need extended learning
- Planning for intervention and extension
- Prioritizing which standards need the most of our instructional time and classroom focus
- Reviewing and fine tuning our pacing of the intended learning for math and reading in light of those instructional priorities.






iStation Reading and Math Distribution Reports for Beginning of Year.



MAPS Reading, Language and Math Reports for Beginning of Year.


