FAMILY PROMISE UPDATE: Our prayers have been answered! As of April 1st a new residential shelter has been provided and will double our capacity to serve families with no place to call home. This new location is at 515 Pacific Ave SW in Willmar, which is north of the downtown area. The rotational model of families moving from church to church each week will be replaced by individual bedrooms and bathrooms for the clients in this shelter. They will continue to utilize First Presbyterian Church for day activities and special programs only. Roseland Reformed will continue to host by providing meals and social interaction approximately 4 weeks per year at this new location. Our first assigned week will be
