NEW BEGINNINGS IN OHIO

===Allison Abbott===

After the [[Grand Siesta]], Abbott had

However, on [[Season 17]], Day 62, Abbott was incinerated by a Rogue Umpire. Guerra and the Worms were playing against the [[Mexico City Wild Wings]] and they did not learn about the incineration until after the game was over.

The [[Dallas Steaks]] gifted her Abbott's nail bat, leaving a nail fixed at the handle akin to a sword's crossguard. Abbott's old teammates had taken the rest of the nails as a keepsake. Guerra accessorized the nail bat by spray-painting it with their pride flag colors, putting a rose insignia on it, and then wrapping it in custom barb wire. Their initials, AA + KG, were engraved into the knob of the bat.

With the help of [[Farrell Seagull]], Guerra constructed a memorial for their old fiancée in the Augusta Chadwell Memorial Park and Promenade which honored incinerated players.

===New Beginnings in Ohio===

Guerra was unexpectedly traded to Ohio in the [[Season 16]] elections. Her old teammate, [[Ortiz Lopez]], had sent a request for [[Pitching Machine]] which was processed seasons late as a trade and played off by The League's upper management as "optics". Lopez and Machine eventually reunited on the [[Atlantis Georgias]] the next season.

During the tour of [[Wapakoneta Air, Space, and Worm Museum and Ballpark|The Wormhole]], she accidentally jumped into [[Ephraim Ladd's]] arms because she had mistaken them to be Abbott, her fiancée at the time. She began to avoid Ladd after that awkward incident.

When [[Igneus Delacruz]] was feedbacked onto the Worms for [[Kaz Fiasco]] on Season 17, Day 28, Guerra quickly adopted them as a friend since the two were new players and Delacruz followed her in the lineup.

[[Farrell Seagull]] had also become a better friend of hers since Seagull was Abbott's old Garages teammate. They've leaned on each other for support especially after Abbott's incineration.

Her other teammates have helped her through the grieving process as well since they had experienced an incineration with [[Augusta Chadwell]]. Guerra has formed an impromptu band with Seagull and [[Loubert Ji-Eun]] where she would scream into the microphone as Loubert plays instruments. Seagull is the merch designer. They're in the process of producing their first EP.

Guerra has an uneasy relationship with their teammate, [[Vessalius Sundae]], because of Sundae's tough love approach after Abbott's death, bluntly telling Guerra to keep playing if she wants to "get outta this funk". [[Rivers Rosa]] is more gentle, encouraging Guerra to engage in anger therapy by imagining the ball as the Umpire's head.

[[Xandra Pancakes]], as the Worms' residential drag artist, helps them cope with a new, edgy makeover. Guerra now has an eyebrow piercing and takes inspiration from the Bōsōzoku Girls and Abbott's grunge style for her wardrobe.

She continues to avoid Ladd.

SUMMARY OF WORMHOLE LOREJAM

- Kichiro's swap with PM was a delayed Ortiz request for PM to be brought to the Lovers, processed seasons late as a trade, and played off by unnamed bureaucrat as "optics"
- Kichiro and Iggy bonded after the Kaz/Iggy feedback, because they're both the newbies (to the Worms team) and next to each other on the lineup
- Kichiro dealt with Allison's incineration by shutting herself in her room and crying a lot.
- Loubert and Farrell help Kichi by starting an impromptu band which is Lou playing instruments, Kichi screaming into a microphone, and Farrell making hastily designed t-shirts
- Vess got the brunt of Kichi's anger because Vess is trying to push for her to feel better, rather than letting her grieve.
- Ephraim keeps their distance as much as possible, on the off chance the angel's appearance causes more distress (cause he might look like Allison, and that's bad™)
- Xandra helps Kichi with her new makeover, taking on some of the edgier aspects of Allison's aesthetic for her own, and getting her eyebrow pierced.

Kichiro's transitioning into a more badass fashion, akin to the Japanese biker gang style, and moody over the loss of her fiancée Allison, adopting some of Allison's traits and some of her things as a means of wanting to hold onto her. The rest of the team's supportive of her, save for Vess, causing the two of them to clash often.

KISS MY BAT EPILOGUE LOREJAM

After the incident, Kichi's been moody, sad and depressed, she wants to be alone so she can grieve and most of the Worms are supportive, a few like Lenny or Farrell occasionally checking in on her to give her some food or make sure she's doing alright or wants to talk about it. Ephraim Ladd, now in the Shadows and just relaxing, is effectively and quietly ushering folks away from her room in the Elder Cottage (One of the Worms' homes) as he knows stuff, and he can tell that Kichi just wants space and will make sure the others respect that. The only people on the team that don't respect Kichi's grieving would be Muse Scantron because he can't exactly process the logic behind grieving for so long, and Vess because she's bullheaded and the only way Vess can think to get Kichi out of her funk is to press head-first into it.

So, Rivers Rosa, she really doesn't like Blaseball, but she's a pitcher. She's pissed at the game for a number of different reasons and Rosa, seeing Kichi going through this, decides to try and help Kichi feel better by getting Kichi into anger therapy.

Rosa: "Look, this game sucks, so don't let it get you down, fight back!"

Kichi: "What are you talking about?"

R: "It's called anger therapy. You let out the rage and anger and spite and all that nasty in you through creative outlets. Like, when I'm pitching, I like to imagine I'm hitting the Commissioner's face with my axe."

K: "Uh-huh....well, I could try imagining the ball as an Umpire's head."

R: "That's the spirit! C'mon, Patch knows of this place where you can get a bunch of junk to smash for like, five bucks an hour. Let's have some fun."

And then Xandra Pancakes, our resident Drag Royalty expert, they're a big supporter of Kichi's redesign of herself. Xandra couldn't care less about incinerations, they think it's a sad event that can happen but the emotional strain's not something that they really support (yet) and they believe that it's best to just let it all out and carry on. As such, Xandra then goes on to help Kichi in the makeover big time. Calls up all the friends they have from different fashion walks of life to help out with the new look, new clothes, gets in touch with Allison's team to see if they can get Kichi some of Allison's clothes from where she lived so that Kichi has more of Allison to carry with her as she continues to play.

From there, Kichi then tries to form a little gang for herself in the Worms, consisting of Rosa, Farrell, Xandra, herself and Cantus. They all ride different bikes, except for Cantus because she has terrible balance (at least how I imagine her, not passed to the rest of the team) and decides to ride with Rosa because they're gardening friends, but sometimes Cantus operates a suped up hoverboard that Muse put together for her so she can keep up with the others.

She rarely rides the hoverboard, 'cause of the balance thing, but she likes to try.

(sidenote: we uh. definitely tried to shadow kichi for that good buff but it didn't happen so i'm choosing to interpret that as kichi's denial/anger phase like nonono she can totally still play blaseball, fuck you she's gonna play blaseball, you can't take this away from her)

2. Iggy Delacruz
3. Farrell Seagull
4. Rivers Rosa
5. Xandra Pancakes
6. Loubert Ji-Eun

Her style is more grunge from Allison's influence. She has Allison's old nail bat. Kichiro is angry™ at the League.

The Worms also have their own alt-universe like Dark Seattle and \$NYC. We call it Althio, it's an alternate universe set in a time that Ohio entered in a hyper-scientific era sometime around the early 80's. The Worms now occasionally go to Althio when they need a pick-me-up.

The only thing missing here is Kichiro's Blacklight lore. Blacklight Mode, or simply "Blacklight," is a paranatural state of being within players from the Ohio Worms. Players who experience overwhelming emotions, be they positive or negative, often trigger the effects of Blacklight and go through a transformative process that brings out their innermost being. Some players take on minor changes while others transform almost completely into a state that matches their state of mind. The Worms are often seen undergoing this change while feeling intense joy. The first recorded instance of Blacklight in ILB history was when the Worms were cheering for their losses in their first season upon returning to the ILB, which resulted in a record - fastest Party Time.

This is DIRECTLY tied to the Wormhole ballpark/Ohio so don't worry about it! The Worms will be creating a wiki page for Blacklight mode sometime in the future and we'll keep the transformations listed there.
