Activity	Summary
Practical Training	 Prior to coming to Catania, complete a disciple-making training for each team member. Everyone will learn to share their testimony, share the Gospel, and start new Bible studies with unbelievers These disciple-making skills will be reviewed in the field and used on a daily basis, sowing Gospel seed and inviting people into new disciple-making relationships All disciple-making skills will be reusable once having returned home!
Abiding in Christ	Join the mission team's daily rhythms of scripture reading and prayer while working in Catania.
Prayer Walks	 Pray daily amongst the neighborhoods and businesses that God would call people to himself, including both refugees and immigrants as well as Sicilians. Prayer walk paths will be outlined by the long-term mission team working in Catania
Outreach in Catania	 Play games in the piazza and in the Agape Center Ride crazy bikes Work in the Agape Bici bike shop Cook and offer BBQ food Share your testimony and the Gospel alongside of the mission team through each of the above activities
Study the Word of God	 Invite new people that you have met into relationship based on the Gospel and the Word of God Read the scriptures together with the new people in a disciple-making Bible study called a 3/3rds Group
Church	 Worship with the church that meets at Agape Bici Option to also attend an Italian church on Sunday
For experienced groups: Train Believers to Make Disciples	 Participate in training believers the basic Search Party disciple-making processes, using the same tools learned in training and while doing outreach in Catania Train how to share the Gospel, how to share your testimony, and how to lead a 3/3rds Group Bible study
Finding Your Purpose in God's Plan	 While in the field, study God's heart and mission amongst the nations Return home both understanding the Biblical basis for going and sending people on missions as well as the practical plan for making disciples and planting churches amongst all people Take home a study that can be used again within your church or small groups

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
