GROUP : THE GUINEA PIGS

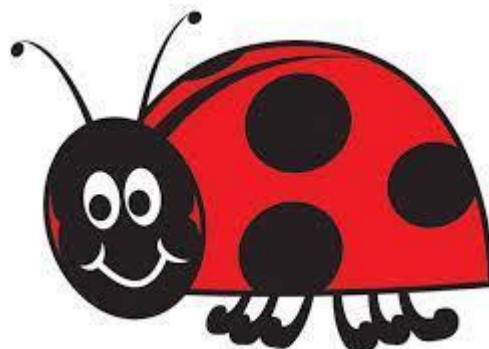

GROUP: THE LADYBIRDS

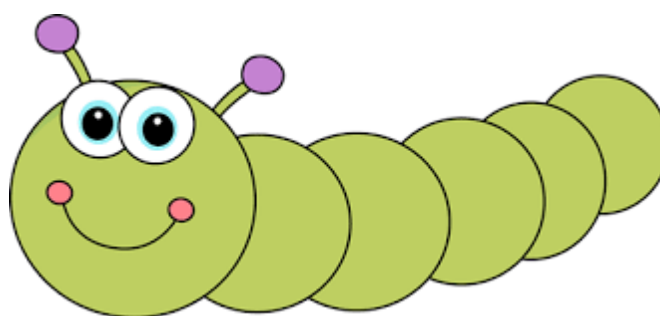
