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Dear Eugene Middle School Families,

As we move into the time of year when winter weather can affect our schedule, we want to share how Alternative Methods of Instruction (AMI) Days will work for middle school if school closures occur.

If we activate an AMI Day due to inclement weather, teachers will post all required assignments on Google Classroom. Students will complete the work labeled for that specific AMI Day (for example, *AMI Day #1*) and submit it through Google Classroom.

Assignments are primarily designed to reinforce skills already taught. However, teachers may occasionally introduce new material. If they do, it will always be accompanied by a clear instructional video or explanation, and the content will be reinforced once students return to school to ensure everyone is on the same page.

To be counted present for an AMI Day, students must turn in their assignments on Google Classroom. If work is not submitted, the state requires us to count the day as an absence.

If your student needs help or has questions about an assignment, please reach out to their teacher. And as always, reading is an excellent way for students to stay sharp on days when we're away from school.

Thank you for partnering with us to ensure learning continues, even when the weather doesn't cooperate. Encourage your student to stay engaged—but also take advantage of the unexpected time to recharge and relax.
