✠ This week, your child learned that:

- ✓ The Gospels are the heart of Scripture since they convey the life, teachings, and Paschal Mystery of our Lord.
- ✓ Each evangelist wrote in a different literary style to convey the Faith to a different audience, highlighting different aspects of Jesus' life.
- ✓ The Incarnation is a dogma of the Church that says that the Son of God became man.
- ✓ God sent the Angel Gabriel to the Virgin Mary to announce to her that she would conceive the Son of God by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- ✓ Jesus is fully divine and fully human.
- ✓ Jesus' entire life and public ministry were focused on proclaiming the message: "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."
- ✓ The Paschal Mystery is how Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection saved us from sin and death for new life as sons and daughters of God.
