GRADUATION CRITERIA

1. Each student must obtain a schedule of Senior activities for the last weeks of school including Graduation practices, picture schedule, final exam week, and other Senior activities requiring their attendance.
2. Student and parent agreement signature on bottom of this form.
3. On the morning of **May 18**, a STUDENT CHECKOUT FORM will be delivered to the first regular class period you attend on the RHS campus. If you still owe any restitution, school/class fees, or library books, contact the office. Each teacher you currently have must then sign the Student Checkout Form as you go to classes. (check out A-day Monday and B-day Tuesday.)
4. ***This Graduation Petition and the Student Checkout Form must be submitted to the RHS Counselor’s Office.*** The counselor will verify completed requirements on CCR/4-year planning sheet. This includes earned credit in all core and elective courses totaling the minimum RHS Graduation Credits.

SPECIAL NOTICE: Graduation is a time of “pomp and circumstance.” We honor graduating seniors for their commitment and goal achievement. These students and their families are very deserving of a DIGNIFIED, MATURE celebration. We have informed students of their expectations and standards for this day. Students are to have appropriate “Sunday Best Dress”.
-No food or gum will be allowed.
-No alterations or added decor to graduation caps or gowns
-No Confetti guns, silly string or any other items that will make a mess or cause a distraction.
There will be a \$100 fine for anyone who violates this rule.
