Debate Preparation & Artificial Intelligence (AI) Inquiry



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Course: EAE2D

Task: Preparing for a structured in-class debate.

Purpose: This handout guides students through the thinking and preparation process for today's debate. You will use artificial intelligence (AI) to support your thinking, but you are responsible for choosing strong ideas, rephrasing them in your own words and preparing to speak clearly and respectfully.

Important reminder: AI is a support, not a replacement for your thinking.

Instruction: Complete each response in the boxes provided.

Step 1: Before using AI, respond to the debate statement on your own.

Step 2: AI Inquiry (Arguments and Counterarguments)

Step 3: Evaluating AI-generated content

Instruction: Evaluate the AI-generated content carefully.
