1. Hypericum Tea (Sonam-Choe-Jha)



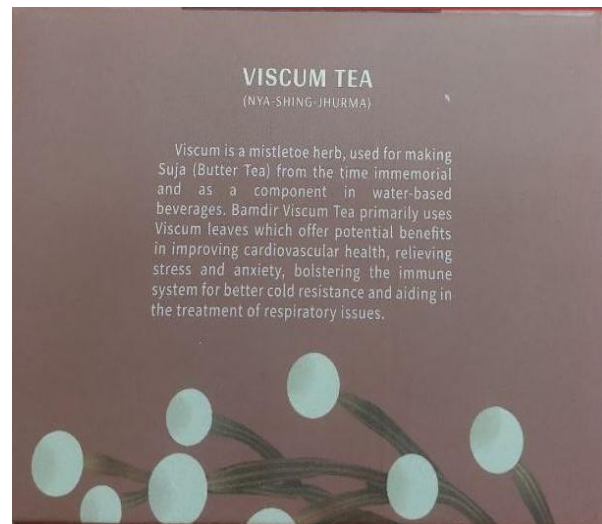
