Abstract

The abstract must be written in English consisted of 200-250 words. It should provide a concise overview that includes the essential background, research objectives, methodology, findings, and main conclusions. Do not use abbreviations or acronyms in the abstract. Citations should not be included in the abstract. Every manuscript submitted to the journal must adhere to these writing guidelines.

Keywords: keywords consist of 3-5 words, separated by a semicolon (;)

Abstract is written in one page.

Introduction (Bold, 11pt)

The introduction includes the background and objectives, and hypothesis (if necessary). The introduction contains the urgent issue either the activities of research or critical analysis. It can also be supported the previous studies by writing last name of the author (use APA style). At the last section of introduction provide the scope of the studies and emphasize on items to be discussed.

Research Method (Bold, 11pt)

In this part employs the methods, source of the data, technique of collecting and analysing data. Those need to explain brief and obvious.

Findings and Discussion (Bold, 11pt)

In this section presents the findings and discussion. It can be supplemented by tables, graphs (figures), and/or chart. In the discussion presents the result of the data that establishing at the finding, and linking with relevant sources.

In providing table, please write the name of the table. The caption of figures must be put at the bottom.

Conclusion (Bold, 11pt)

In conclusion contains a brief summary of the result of research, suggestion for researcher, readers, and for the next researchers.

References (Bold, 11pt Mendeley)

Reference should include at least 15 references using APA style, write alphabetical order. The reference approximately 60% should be from recent scientific journals, it is better in the last five or 10 years. This manuscript is recommended to use Mendeley, Zotero, and others.
