

Music Performance - Composition and Theory, BM

All music majors must complete a successful [audition](#) and [apply](#) to the Composition and Theory program.

Placement Exams for the Major:

1. MAT 1010 will fulfill the math requirement for this major. You can register for MAT 1010 regardless of your SAT/ACT score and you do not need the Math Placement Test. Consult with your academic advisor if you want to consider a higher level math course for any reason.

If you have already been **accepted** into the [Hayes School of Music](#), your 1st semester schedule will be built for you.

For all students who **intend** to major in Music but who have not yet successfully [auditioned](#), here are recommended courses:

1. RC 1000 or UCO 1200 if there are seats available. If not, it's fine to take both classes in the spring semester.
2. Enroll in MUS 2618 (Intercultural Literacy ICL/FA)
3. Enroll in MAT 1010 (see Math Placement note above)
4. Enroll in a **Wellness Literacy** course - MUS 2054, Alexander technique completes this general education requirement.
5. Enroll in 1 hr Ensemble: possibly [MUS 1100 - Marching Band](#), [MUS 1104 - Jazz Ensemble](#), [MUS 1107 - Small Ensembles](#), [MUS 1109 - Appalachian Chorale \(no audition required\)](#), [MUS 1111 - ASU Glee Club](#), [MUS 1110 - Treble Choir](#) or [MUS 1108 - University Singers](#), [MUS 1117 - Gospel Choir \(no audition required\)](#)

Students who are not admitted to the Hayes School of Music should review the [Preliminary Information for Students Considering Music](#) document as well.

Alternative Courses for Your First Semester:

Can't get into the classes above? Try these:

- MUS 1000 (Elements of Music Theory, not required but may help prospective students prepare for program admission).
- [Foundations of American Democracy](#) course
- SS (Social Science) designation.
- LS (Literary Studies) designation *note that ENG courses require RC 1000 as a prerequisite.
- Science of your choosing (Exploring Science is encouraged by the School of Music). Must have math prerequisites.
 - [PHY 1812 - Acoustics and Harmonics \(4\)](#) Fall only
 - [PHY 1814 - Sound and Recording \(4\)](#) Spring only

***Note:** Admitted Music students will be required to take MUS 2617 which have the (HS) designation you need.
