

Wonder Box Sewing Instructions

Included in Kit:

- 2 -Zippers
- 2 -Clips
- 4 -Strips of Webbing
- 4 -18in. diameter fabric circles
- 1- 54 x 10 Strip of fabric
- 1 - 54 x 18 Strip of fabric

1. Fold fabric strip in half then half again. Place webbing on fold on both sides. Pin one end. Take same half of clips and pin to webbing. Sew ends of webbing down.

Note: Make sure you use the same clip part for the same fabric strip. Female part on top cushion and male part on bottom cushion or vice versa.

2. Repeat for other fabric strip.

3. Place zipper to the ends of your fabric. This should make a circle. If you were to make a circle and cut into fours you should have a plain front a zipper on the opposite end and clips on the sides. 4. Repeat step 3 with other strip of fabric.

5. Turn fabric strips inside out keeping zippers zipped. Put right sides together sew fabric circles to inside of strips. (Small tucks or bunching may occur. This does not effect cooking.) Just make sure there are no openings.

6. Repeat with all four circles. Once completing you should have 2 cushion covers. One large one small.

7. Turn right side out. Fill cushions with polystyrene beads about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way full. This is where you need to use the pot you will be cooking in to gauge how full you want your box to be. Having the box to full will cook slower. Less is better. When finished it is like a Loose bean bag.

Note: Smiths Marketplace is the only store I have found Polystyrene beads. They are about \$12 a bag. Find them in the furniture section with the bean bags. You need about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a bag to fill your Wonder Box. Your Wonder Box is ready to use.
