Our goal is to test all students in the morning and in small groups. You will have 2 days given for testing in reading and math. There will be NO INTERVENTIONS, NO READING ROOM, AND NO FLEX this week.

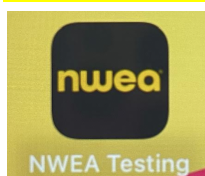
- Reading Room teachers will come to your room and take the remaining half of the class who are not testing that day upstairs. Send those students with their iPads and headphones.
- Students with testing accommodations will work with their resource teacher (Shandi or Rachel.) They will send you a separate testing schedule. Do not test these students with your class, just send them with the Reading Room teacher.
- **Use your flex, intervention, or reading room time this week for any students who need to finish testing.**
- If you aren't able to finish testing this week between Flex, interventions, reading room, and your scheduled testing time, you will finish testing in your classroom the following week.

- **Makeups:** add any students who need to makeup the test to the makeup tabs on the [schedule](#). Students who need to make up the test can join the other testing group or take the test during flex, reading room, or interventions. Reach out to Stacey or admin if you need assistance with makeups.

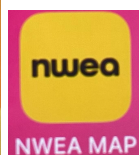
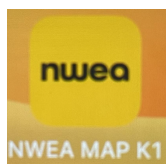
Day of Set Up:

- Have students set up privacy offices
- Have students you want to make sure are on task and not rushing sit at the same table so you can monitor closely
- Provide blank paper and pencil for the math test
- Give students their bookmarks to remind them of their target score (1st-3rd grade)
- Be an “active proctor” while students are testing (walk around and make sure they are not quick clicking)
- When students finish testing, have them keep their office up and silently go on an app while other students are still testing.
- Write down student scores on the [MAP Data Tracker](#) as they finish testing

Day of Proctoring/ Troubleshooting:



This is what the app looks like. Please use this app so you can lock students into the app while they test.



These are backup links (Eric pushed out the links as buttons) in case we have any issues with the

app. You can't lock students in using these, so please try with the actual gray app first.

- If a student gets kicked out of the test:
 - Go to the test session on your computer
 - Check the student's name
 - Choose "Suspend" from the "Select Actions" drop down
 - Check the student's name again
 - Choose "Test Again" from the "Select Actions" drop down
 - Now students can close out of the app, reopen it, and log in again
- If the test has a white screen:
 - Close out all your apps and tabs in safari, then try again
 - Restart your iPad and try again
 - With the white screen up, wait 5 minutes. It might just take awhile for the app to load.
- If a question is taking a long time to load on the screen:

- Click the “reset” button on the bottom to reload the question

Testing Scores/ Data Entry:

- You may retest the students at your discretion.. **Email admin with the score you would like to keep.**
Check-in with admin if you have any questions!
- Fill in the grade level data sheets using the Achievement Status and Growth (Fall → Winter) Report when your class is done testing
