The Weymouth High School Guidance Department has compiled the following electronic resources to assist students, parents, and guardians around the college admissions and financial aid processes. Please note that these resources supplement face to face meetings with all seniors and/or guardians throughout senior year. Additionally, interested underclassmen are welcome to partake in these resources.

Sample Senior Year Timeline for those students pursuing direct entry to a bachelor (four-year) college admissions;

- <u>September/October</u> = Student Meetings & Application prep/submission if seeking "Early Admissions"
 - If applicable, register for a Fall SAT Exam (Oct/Nov/Dec test dates are offered)
 - SAT Registration @ https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/sat/registration
- Oct/Nov/Dec = Families work on and submit the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
 - Additionally, some private colleges may require the *CSS Profile*, an additional application for aid.
- Nov/Dec/Jan = Application prep and submission if seeking "Regular/Rolling Admissions"
- <u>Dec/Jan/Feb</u> = Students research and apply for Scholarships (deadlines vary by scholarship)
- <u>Feb/Mar/April</u> = Family discussion and decision making around college attendance (you should have all admissions and financial aid information by this time). The universal deadline for tuition deposit (enrollment at a college or university) is May 1st.

Additionally, please know that counselors are here to help you when individual questions arise. We look forward to working together to make this year as successful as possible as we aid students/families in crafting a plan for success post WHS graduation.

The WHS Guidance Department now utilizes *Scoir*! What is *Scoir*? *Scoir* is a customized, secure website that supports post-secondary, college and career planning. It is designed to assist students and their parents/guardians in making informed decisions about college opportunities and career choices. This online resource allows Juniors and Seniors the ability to research colleges, view statistical and historical data on other WHS students anonymously, build a resume, take a career interest inventory, view the schedule of college representatives visiting the high school and much more. Scoir is offered as a complement to the series of individual and group meetings that are available to students and families in partnership with the Counseling Department.
