 Math 8: Students will be finishing up/starting or continuing with Solving Functions/Linear vs. Nonlinear Functions next week as well as continuing with Volume of 3D Shapes such as Rectangular Prisms, Cylinders, Cones, and Spheres. Students will also be Introduced to the New Exponents Unit.

#### Math I:

 Students will be starting/continuing with Solving Solving Systems of Equations next week as well as Graphing Linear Inequalities on a X-Y Coordinate Plane/Grid in preparation for their Unit Test. Students will also be introduced to Comparing Parallel vs. Perpendicular Lines.
